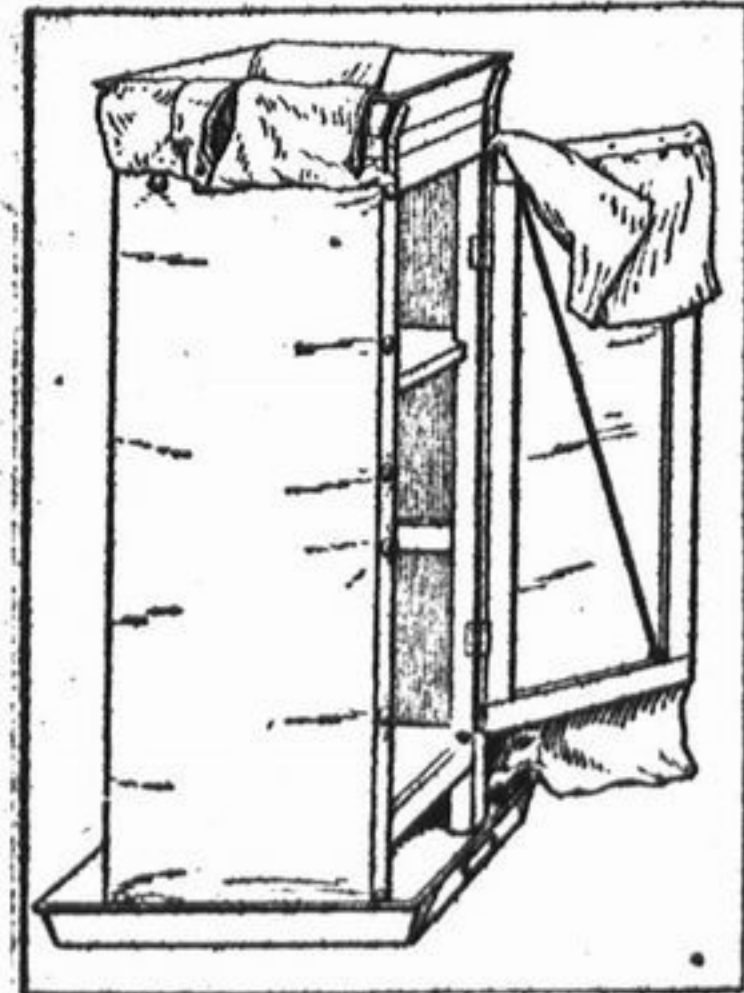


Rapid Evaporation of Water Secret of Success of The Iceless Refrigerator

Iced Cocoa.

Strawberries Preserved Whole.

Crush two quarts of strawberries, using the small ones, and simmer gently for twenty minutes, then strain. Allow a pound of sugar to a pint of juice. Heat the sugar and add the juice as soon as it is strained. Return to the stove and boil until thick, skimming carefully when necessary.

"Women's Town" in France.

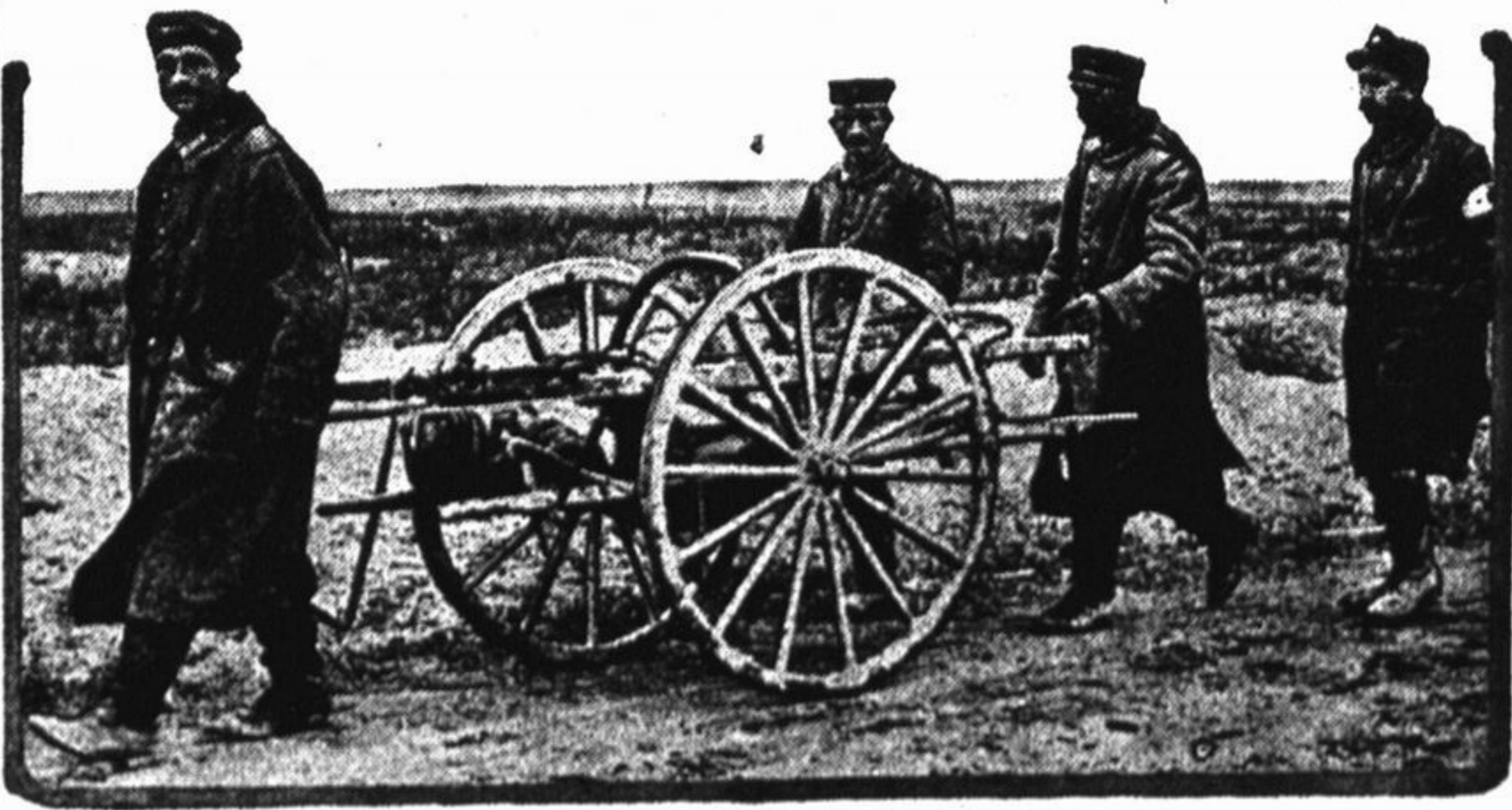
A new "women's town" in the Valley of the Romanche, a few miles from Grenoble, is one of the evolutions of the "munitions campaign" in France.

Overhoes have been patented that are stamped from sheet metal and are formed that they will not slip on wet or icy surfaces.



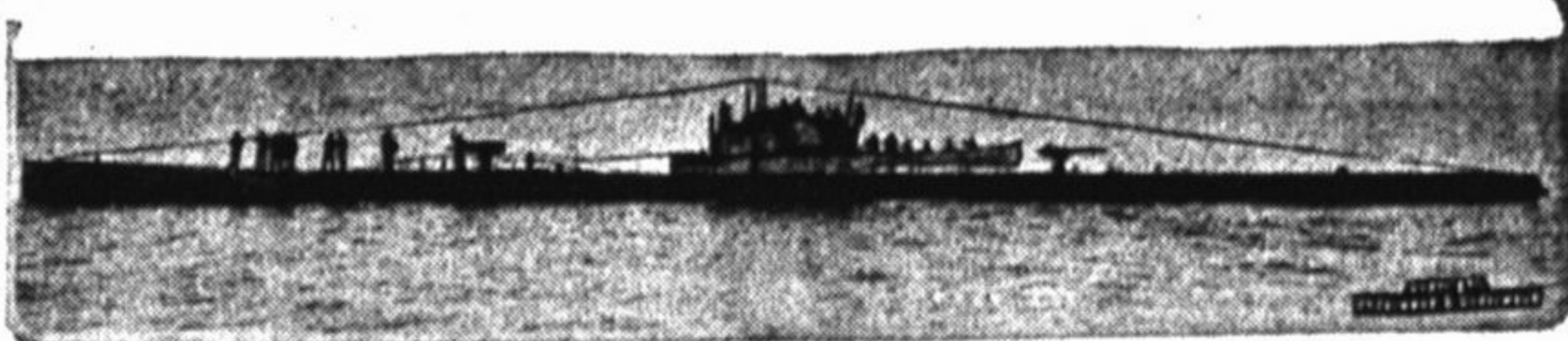

MAKING USE OF GERMAN PRISONERS OF WAR



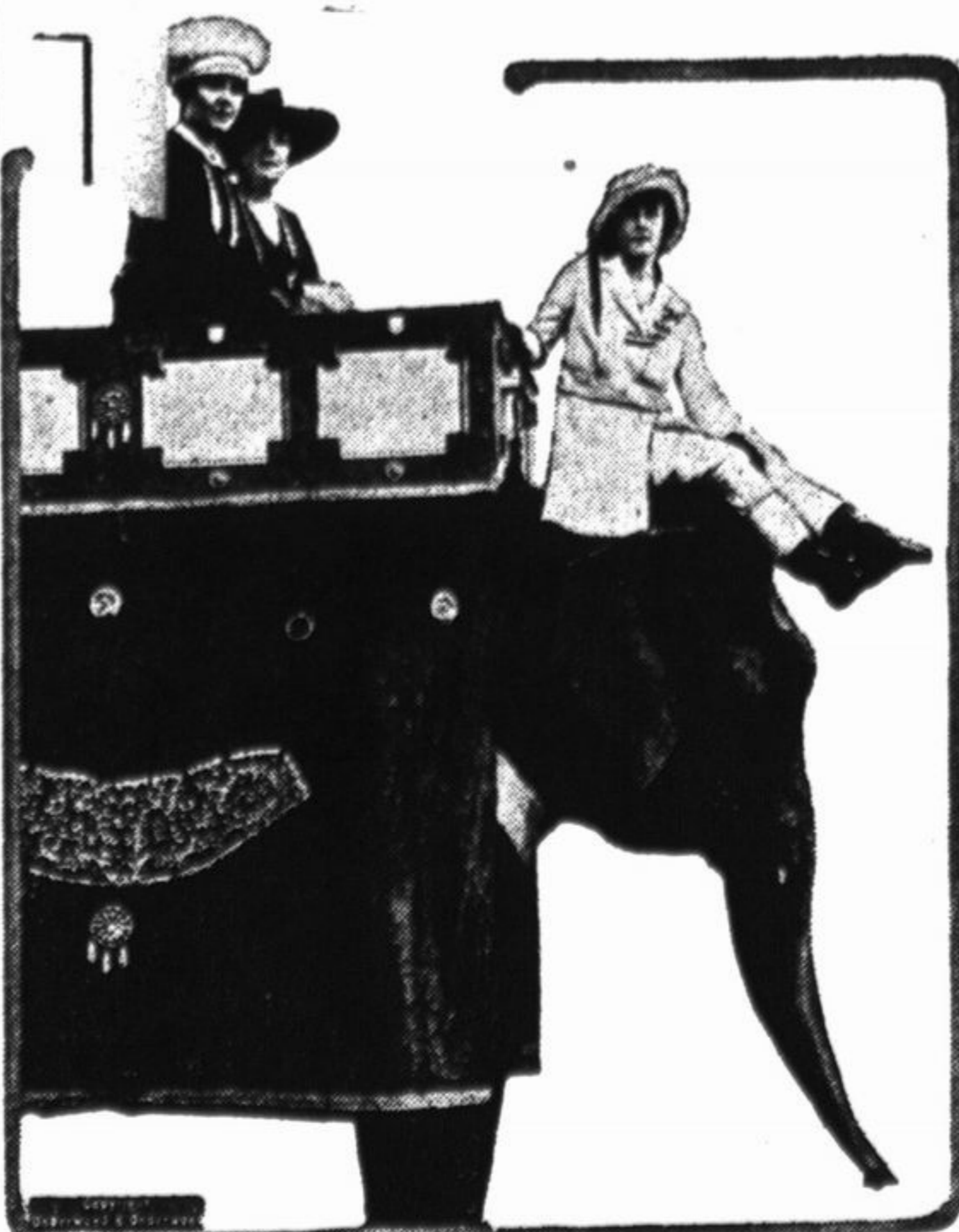
German prisoners of war with a stretcher cart used for bringing in the wounded, at St. Hilaire, France.
