Downers Grove, Illinois,
June 25th, 1917
An ordinance amending the fees provided for in paragraph one (1), rule three, (3), section fourteen, (14) chapter forty-eight, (48), of an ordinance entitled "Water System and Matters Relating Thereto."
Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Downers Grove Illinois and State of Illinois, Rule Three (3) The Sum of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25) shall be paid for water service connections, instead of Sixteen Dollars (\$16) as provided in said section Section (17) Seventeen.
This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication, according to law.
