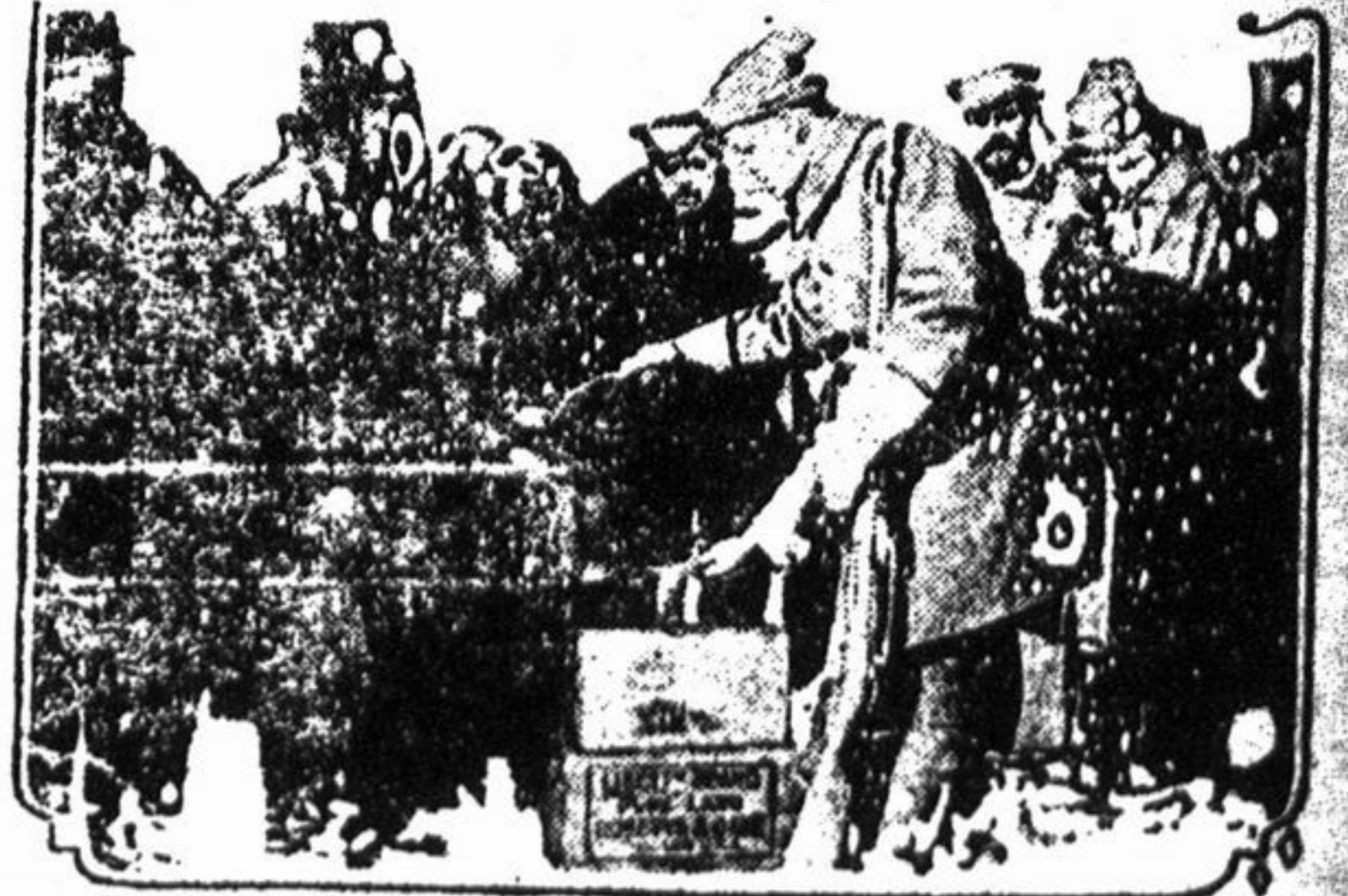
to other fields. A wireless telephone in the airplane enables the manager to keep in constant communication with the ranch headquarters.

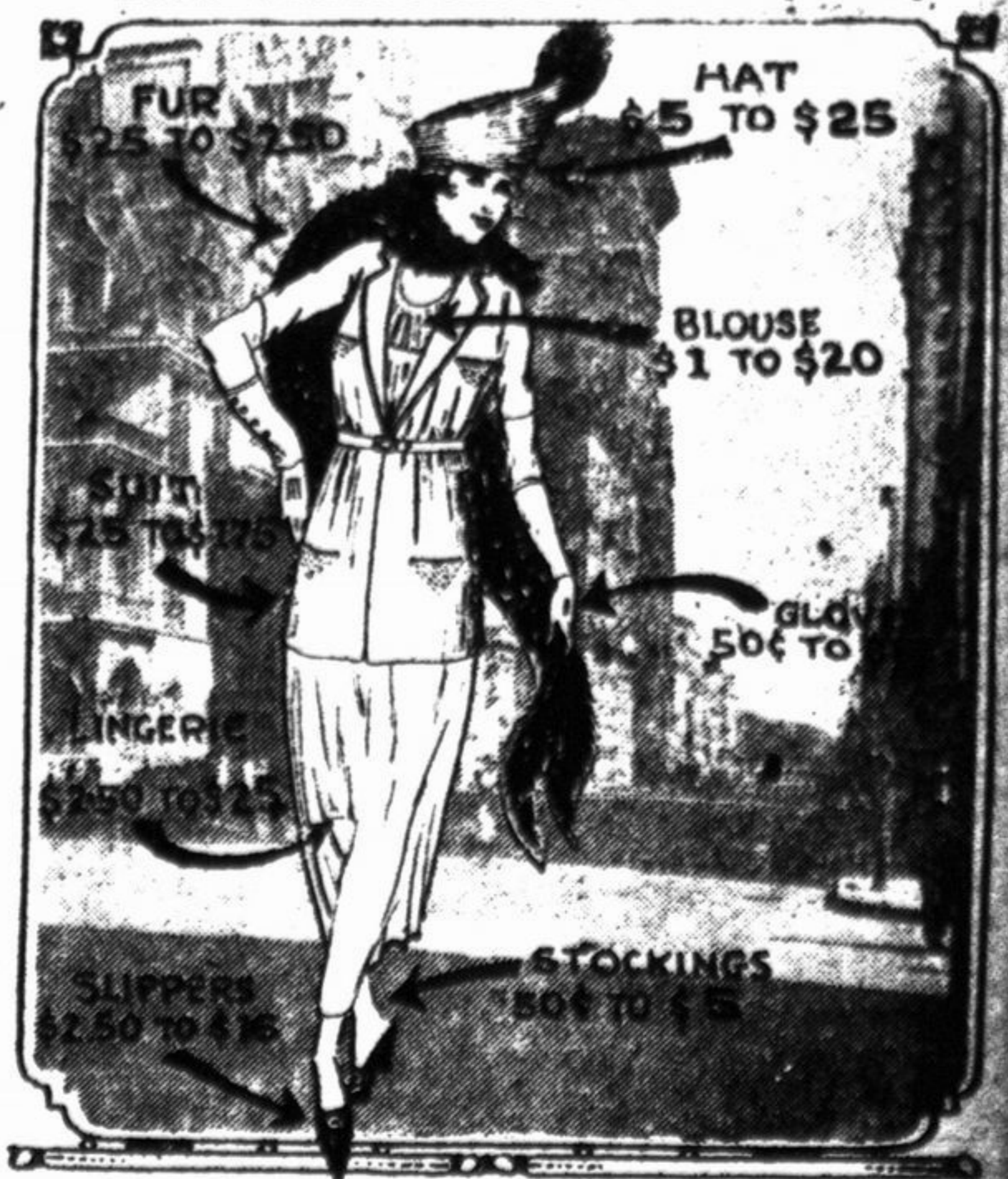
Three congressmen elected by the sixty-sixth congress when it convenes shortly. They are George M. Young, James H. Sinclair and J. M. Baer.

Easy to See Through New Designs



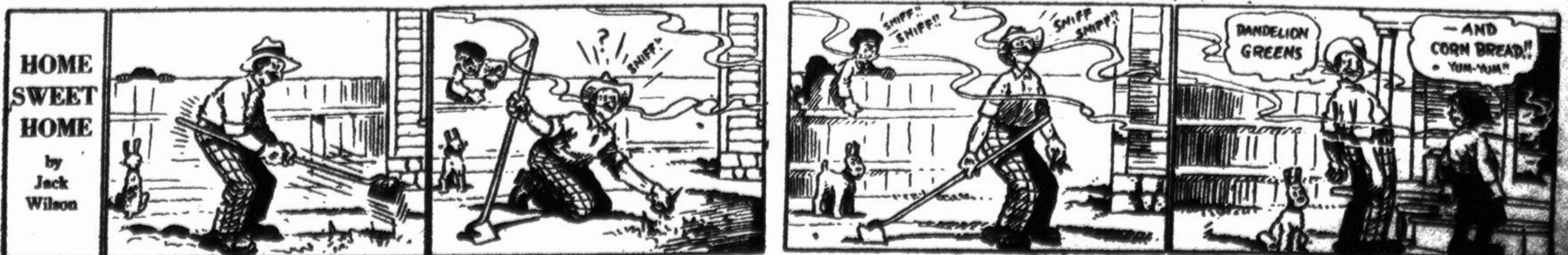
