ING RELATIVES OF **DEAD SOLDIERS**

Washington, Feb. p1.-Vernon A. Callar, 38, a Virginian, was today held to the federal grand jury on a charge of using the mails to defraud hundreds of bereaved relatives of American soldiers reported dead or missing . The offense which figured in his arraignment today was the obtaining of funds from Mrs. John B. Bryan of Downers Grove, Ill., on the rretext of furnishing transportation lome for her son. John B. Bryan Jr., formerly with the marine corps.

Bryan was reported missing in action by the War Department. Callar wrote Mrs. Bryan that he had found her son, that he had deserted and would not appeal to the authorities for help for fear that he would be imprisoned.

Mrs. Bryan knew her son wasn't the kind to desert and turned the letter over to the Marine Corps headquarters in Washington. Callar's arest followed. He has confessed to sending hundreds of messages for funds to bereaved women in Illinois, Iowa. Michigan and Missouri,
