**VILLAGE ORDINANCE NO. 30**

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE CHICAGO TELEPHONE CO. CERTAIN RIGHTS IN THE VILLAGE OF DOWNERS GROVE, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Council of the Village of Downers Grove, Illinois:

SECTION 1. That the Chicago Telephone Company, its successors, lessees and assigns, are hereby granted the right to construct, erect, renew, maintain and operate for a period of twenty (20) years from and after the passage and acceptance of this ordinance and thereafter until terminated upon (60) days written notice, in, upon, along, across, under and over the streets, alleys and public places of the Village of Downers Grove, lines of poles, wires, cables, conduits, vaults and laterals and to use the same for supplying the general public means of communication by telephone or other electrical device.

SECTION 2. The location of the lines of poles now existing is hereby approved and any change therein or extension thereof, as well as the construction of conduits, vaults and laterals shall be made under the direction of the Chairman of Committee on Streets and Alleys, or any such other officer as may be from time to time designated by the Village Council, who shall issue written permits therefor. All poles erected hereunder shall be first class poles of symmetrical and uniform shape, smoothly shaved and shall be painted and kept painted a uniform color.

SECTION 3. Said Company after doing any excavating shall leave the surface of the ground in a neat graded condition. All sidewalks, parkways, or pavements disturbed by said Company shall be restored by it to as good condition as before such sidewalk, parkway or pavement was opened or disturbed by it. All wires, poles, conduits, vaults and laterals of said Company within said Village shall be so placed and maintained and all work of said Company shall be so performed as not to interfere with ordinary travel on the highways of said Village or with water, sewer or other pipes or conduits which said Village may now or hereafter lay and in case of bringing to grade or change of width of any street or alley said Company shall change its structures so as to conform thereto. The tops of all vaults constructed under this ordinance shall present an even surface with the street pavement at the point where laid, and shall be lowered or raised by said Company as required by the Village Council of said Village whenever the grade of the street or alley in which said conduit is located may be at any time hereafter lowered or raised.

SECTION 4. Said Company shall keep all structures constructed and maintained by it in said Village in a proper and safe condition at all times and shall maintain such barriers and shall maintain during the construction, repair or renewal of all work performed under the provisions of this ordinance as will reasonably avoid damage and injury to life, limb and property. Said Company shall at its own expense defend said Village on account of and in connection with the rights hereunder granted, or that may be brought against said Village under or by virtue of this ordinance or by reason of anything done by said Company hereunder, and shall save and keep harmless said Village from any and all damages, judgments, costs and expenses of every kind that may arise or grow out

of said work, and that may arise in any manner whatsoever under or by virtue of this ordinance or any of the provisions thereof provided that notice in writing shall be given to said Company of the occurrence of any accident, or the institution of any suit for which said Company may be liable under the provisions of this section.

SECTION 5. No trees along any of the streets or alleys shall be cut or trimmed without the consent of the owner of the abutting property nor without the written permission of the Chairman of the street and alley Committee or such other officer as shall be from time to time designated by the Council of said Village for that purpose.

SECTION 6. Whenever in view of necessity of building moving and the Council of said Village shall so require, after twenty-four (24) hours written notice, said Company shall move its poles and cut its wires and cables after the owner or mover of the building to be moved shall have deposited with the Company an amount not to exceed the estimated actual cost of caring for, splicing and replacing said poles, wires and cables. Such cost shall be paid out of said deposit, and any amount unexpended from any sum so deposited shall be returned to the person making the deposit.

SECTION 7. Said Chicago Telephone Company will permit the Village of Downers Grove the use of sufficient space for carrying the Village police and fire alarm wires at the top of all poles erected hereunder, provided that such wires shall be so placed and maintained by said Village that the use of same will not impair the operation of said poles. All such police and fire alarm wires shall be attached and maintained under the direction and supervision of said Company's authorized representative and upon the following conditions: No such police or fire alarm wire shall be attached to any of said poles of said Company if such wires shall carry a voltage of more than one hundred (100) volts nor if any part of the circuit of such wire is supported upon a pole on which there is any wire carrying a voltage of five thousand (5000) volts or more. In case any such police and fire alarm wire in any part of its circuit is supported upon a pole on which there is any wire carrying a voltage of less than five thousand (5000) volts and more than one hundred (100) volts, then such police and fire alarm wire shall be attached to such pole at a point not less than five (5) feet below such wire carrying such voltage of less than five thousand (5000) volts and more than one hundred (100) volts.

SECTION 8. Said Company, so long as it exercises or enjoys the rights hereunder, shall furnish to the Village of Downers Grove, free of charge, with local exchange service for Village business only, eight (8) telephones to be installed in such places within such Village as the Council of said Village from time to time shall, by resolution direct, provided that said Company's usual form of contract for each telephone shall be previously signed for the Village by the Mayor thereof, having endorsed thereon the terms specified. When said Company's usual form provided therefor shall have been previously signed by such Mayor, said Company shall, without charge, change the location of any of said telephones provided that not more than one such change of location in any one year for any telephone furnished hereunder shall be made by said Company without expense to the Village. Said Company shall also furnish to said Village and its officers free toll service on strictly Village business from Downers Grove to all points on said

Company's lines in DuPage County, Illinois, and also from Downers Grove to all points on the toll lines of said Company between Chicago and Aurora, including said cities, provided that said free toll line service shall not in any one year exceed the sum of one hundred (100) dollars, and that such Mayor shall certify on statements for such free toll service rendered by said Company from month to month that the several calls listed thereon were made on the business of the Village of Downers Grove. Said Company shall also install and put in operation not later than twenty-four (24) months from the date of its acceptance hereof, the equivalent of a multiple telephone system for the operation of the lines of its subscribers in said Village of Downers Grove. Said Company shall also remove its poles from Main Street between Warren Avenue and Maple Avenue, not later than twelve (12) months from the date of said acceptance hereof.

SECTION 9. In case said Company shall fail or neglect to comply with any or all of its obligations as expressed in any of the conditions or provisions of this ordinance unless the compliance by said Company with such condition or provision is prohibited or adjudged unlawful by an order of the Illinois State Public Utilities Commission or by the order of any other body, board, commission or court of competent jurisdiction, said Village reserves the right to repeal this ordinance or rescind the contract and forfeit the rights hereby created or sought to be created, provided that no such forfeiture of such rights shall exist or be claimed because of such failure or neglect until written notice of such failure or neglect so claimed shall have been given to said Company and a reasonable opportunity afforded it to correct the things complained of, and by such correction to duly comply with the provisions of this ordinance, or to prove that such compliance has already existed. In the event that the Illinois State Public Utilities Commission or any other body, board, or commission or court of competent jurisdiction shall so adjudge any provision or provisions hereof invalid, illegal or void, such invalidity or illegality shall in no way affect the validity or legality of the remaining provisions of this ordinance and this ordinance in all other respects shall continue in full force and effect as if such provision or provisions had not been so adjudged invalid, illegal or void. If the furnishing by the Company of the service provided for in Section 8 hereof, without charge, therefore, is adjudged invalid, illegal or void for said reason by the State Public Utilities Commission of Illinois, or any other body, board, commission or court of competent jurisdiction, then said Company shall furnish such service at the lawful rates therefor and in lieu of said free service and a substitute therefor, pay to said Village annually the sum of money equivalent to the lawful rates for service which would have been rendered under Section 8 hereof.

SECTION 10. Said Company's rates for exchange service in said Village shall not exceed the rates charged by said Company in other municipalities in Illinois under like conditions for similar classes of service. The said rates shall for all purposes be subject to the jurisdiction of the Illinois State Public Utilities Commission or any other body, board, commission or court authorized by law to establish such rates.

SECTION 11. All grants, franchises, rights and privileges hereto for made or granted to said Company by said Village by ordinance or otherwise and now existing, are hereby revoked and rendered of no effect, and all ordinances and resolutions of said Village granting rights and privileges to said Company in said Village, are hereby repealed, it being the intent that this ordinance shall take the place of all prior existing ordinances, resolutions and franchises granted to said Company by said Village.

SECTION 12. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of said Village of Downers Grove, its approval by the Mayor thereof, and after the same shall have been duly authorized or approved by a majority of the electors of said Village of Downers Grove, voting thereon at a general or special election, as required by law, called by the Council of the Village of Downers Grove for such purpose and as soon thereafter as said Chicago Telephone Company shall file with the Village Clerk its written and unconditional acceptance of the terms and conditions in this ordinance, provided that if said Company shall not file an acceptance in writing of this ordinance within thirty (30) days of the date of said election (in the event said Ordinance is authorized and approved at said election hereinabove referred to) then this ordinance shall be of no force and effect and all rights herein granted shall absolutely cease and terminate.

Refused to Accept Badly Printed Lot of Labels from Economy Printing Company.

In a suit brought before Judge Tucker last Saturday by the Economy Printing Company against the Indu Kosmetic Company, of this Village, the latter received the decision.

The Indu Company almost a year ago ordered from the printing concern 120,000 labels. When the first of these arrived here, they were found to be so badly printed that Mr. Smith of the Indu Company, refused to accept them. After looking over the rest of the order in the Economy plant in Chicago, he also refused the entire order. The Economy people brought suit to recover the amount of the bill and after postponing the case several weeks, it was finally heard last Saturday before Judge Tucker, who rendered a decision in favor of the local concern.
