

**OPEN AIR SERVICES COMMENCE SUNDAY, JULY 11**

"The Lordship of Jesus Christ," is Topic Chosen for Sermons by Local Pastors.

Arrangements are being completed for the Community Services to be held again this year at the Church of the Closed Street. Five churches cooperate in this union movement.

Since these union Sunday evening services were introduced a few summers ago the spirit of cooperation and fellowship among the Protestant churches of the village has grown.

"The Church of the Closed Street" is no longer an experiment. It has become a part of the community life because the community appreciates such an expression of cooperation of Christian forces. We look forward to another successful season this summer.

The original plans called for the opening service at the Church of the Closed Street on July 4th, but after learning of the plans of the local boys of the American Legion it was decided to postpone the opening until July 11th but dismiss our evening services at the churches July 4th so that as many of the church people as possible can attend the lecture arranged for in the Chautauqua program.

During the first five services in the open air the pastors of the local co-

operating churches will preach in rotation. For the remaining evenings the best of outside talent available will be secured.

The Pastor's Union thought it most beneficial to adopt some constructive and unified program and has adopted as the general subject for the first five services, "The Lordship of Jesus Christ." This general theme will be treated in sub-topics as follows:

July 11—"The Lordship of Jesus Christ in Personal Life," by Rev. John Stewart of the Baptist Church.

July 18—"The Lordship of Jesus Christ in Home Life," by Rev. Wm. Grotefeld of the Grove Street Evangelical Church.

July 25—"The Lordship of Jesus Christ in Industrial Relations," by Rev. A. S. Phelps of the Methodist Church.

August 1—"The Lordship of Jesus Christ in Church Life," by Rev. T. J. Owens of the Congregational Church.

August 8—"The Lordship of Jesus Christ in Social Life," by Rev. J. A. Nansen of the First Evangelical Church.

The opening song service will again be a feature of the services. Special music will be supplied each Sunday evening by the church whose pastor delivers the message. A volunteer choir and orchestra is again desired by the Music Committee composed of the Messrs. Roe, Morton and Lehmann. The opening song service will start at 7:45 throughout the series.
