#### J. B. BERRYMAN GIVES COST OF RUNNING SCHOOLS

Compares La Grange and Deerfield High Schools With Proposed Local One.

July 26, 1920.

To the Editor of The Reporter; I have read, with interest the statement of the Downers Grove Board of Education on the Communi ty High School. The proposed levy for the present is set at \$1.11 per 100 of valuation. This will produce \$30,000, which is so inadequate that - the proposition is not worth considering.

The maximum rate is set at \$2.00 per 100, to produce \$56,000, and as a first-class High School cannot be opcrated for that sum, it will be necessary to raise the rate, or the assessed value.
