

**RICHELIEUS ARE LEADING BOWLERS END OF 2ND WEEK**

Scores Getting Better as Pin Men Get Stride—East Ends in High Season Game.

Bowlers in the "Big League" are getting more pins. The first series was rather a tame affair as the wood getters were bowling for the first time this season and had not yet entered into the swing of the game.

From this time on interest and the scores should improve from week to week.

Klein's Richelieus are holding the top of the list in the team standing being the only five which has come thru with a clean slate. In the series with the Mills Printing Co. last week Stump, team captain, again started rolling three consistent games for an average of 181 2-3. Ehninger got high game with 210. For the printers Duncan led with 139 2-3 average his high game being 164.

Swearingen's Pace Makers took all three from the Dicke Climbers, Bodelman being high man for the winners with an average of 171 and 185 for high game. For the Climbers Brady was high with 192.

The East Ends piled up high team score for the season in the middle game of their series with the Progressive Five counting 874 pins. They took two out of the three games. Staats getting high average, 166 2-3 with high game going to Mrkvička, 194. Glaab easily starred for the Progressives with an average of 178 1-3 and high game of 197.

Camp of Pitcher's Boosters hit 'em for 210 in their first game with the American Legion and pulled down an average of 191 for the three. The Legion team was handicapped by the absence of two good bowlers and lost two out of three. Nash's average of 176 2-3 was high.

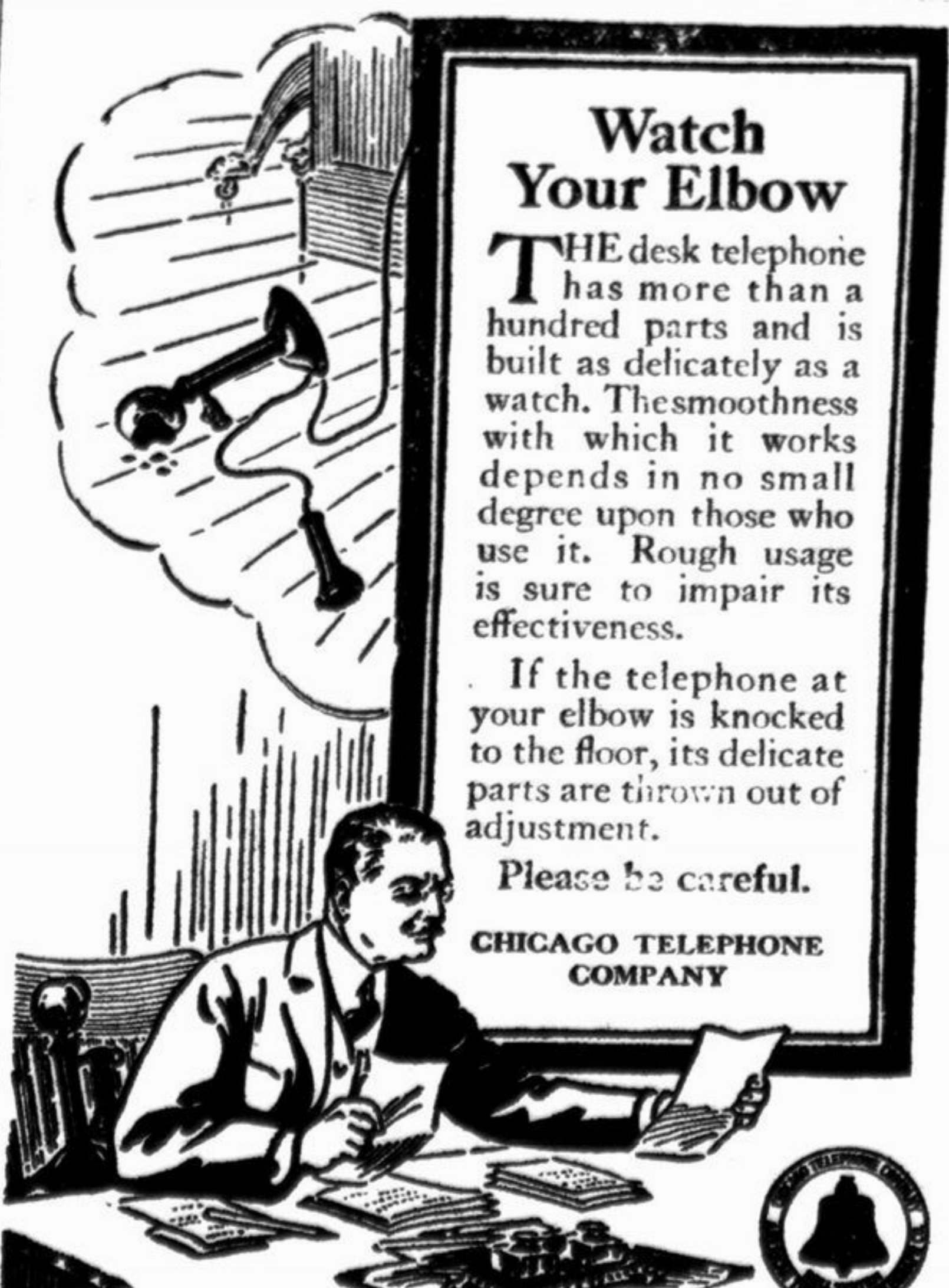

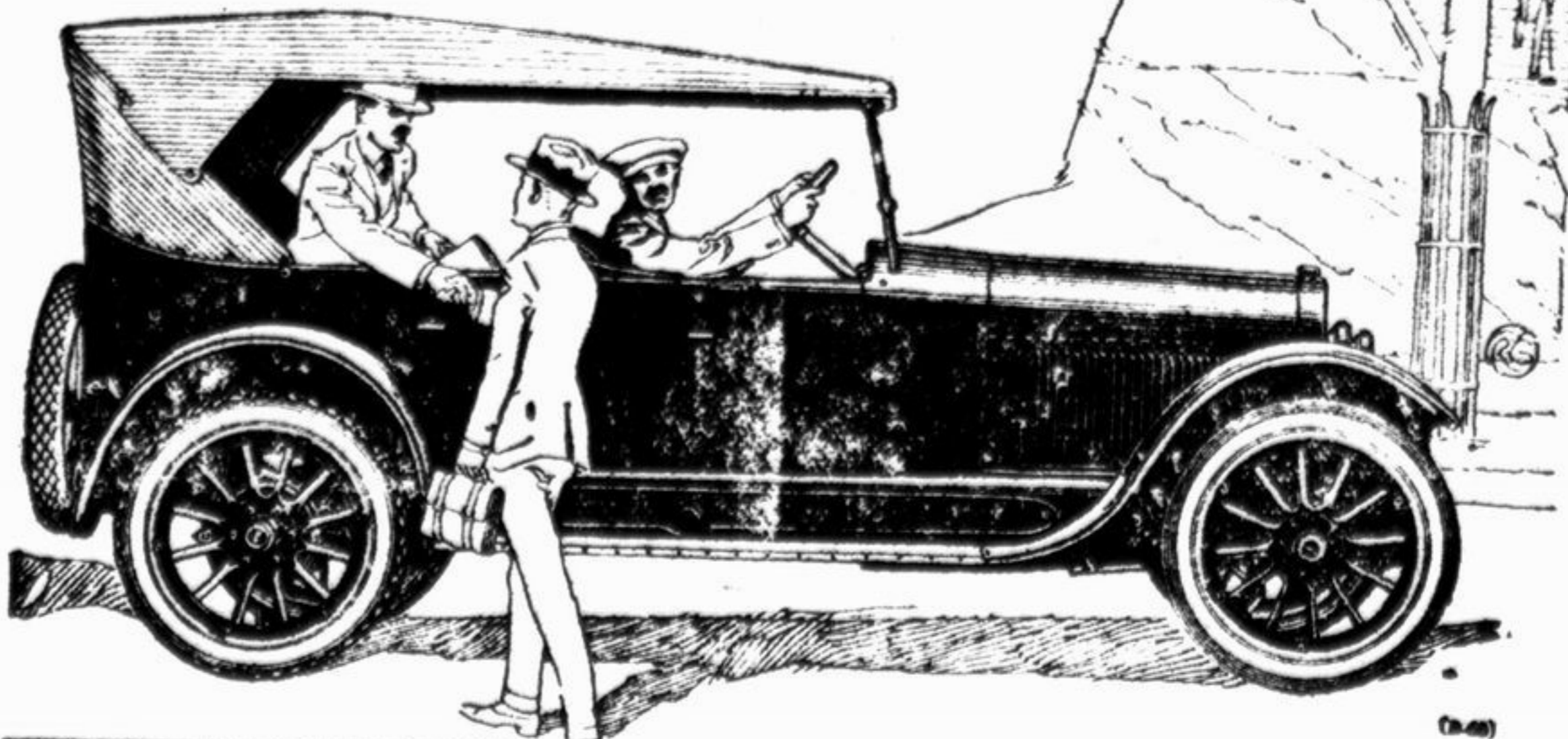
