Bell System Wrong Numbers If, for any reason, you are connected with a telephone other than the one you called, move the receiver hook slowly up and down four or five times, or until the operator answers. (The signal will not operate if hook is moved rapidly.) Tell her that you have been given a wrong number, and repeat the number you called for. This routine is necessary to avoid the possibility of having the nickel "collected" by the operator (if using a coin box telephone), or having the call charged (if using a measured service telephone). Notice to Gas Consumers Even if you don't own an automobile you are probably familiar with its design. You know that the mixing appliance needs to be readjusted occasionally, due to slight change in fuel, slight change in atmospheric conditions, slight clogging through constant use, and, natural changes brought about by daily operating. Any machine or appliance that was ever made, needs occasional readjustment — a watch does — a lathe does — a washing machine does — so does a gas lamp. If you are having trouble with your stove and can't wait for our men to come to your house, simply take your screwdriver, and loosen the adjusting slide in front of the stove handle where you turn on the gas. Open or close this slide as necessity requires. The gas should burn with a sharp blue-green flame, but should not pop back into the mixer. When this flame appears, you will have what you want—perfect combustion. The best gas in the world will pop, sputter, and smoke if the appliance adjustment is not right. Don't fail to inform us if your trouble continues. There is an adjustment slide on every mantle lamp. Open or close this slide as necessity requires. Your lamp is operating perfectly when it ceases to sputter and when the mantle gives a full white glow with no flame at the top. In the months and probably years to come you may find it necessary to economize in every possible way. Don't overlook the low cost of gas for lighting purposes. Don't forget that gas, next to sunlight, is easiest on the eyes. Don't rush to some other source of light. Before you make any change, be sure that it is for the better instead of worse.
