Grove at its next regular election in accordance with an Act of the General Assembly entitled "An Act providing for the annexing and excluding territory to and from cities, towns and villages, and to unite cities, towns and villages" and all acts amendatory thereof, approved April 10th, 1872, in force July 1st, 1872.

Your petitioner further prays that in the event that the majority of the votes cast at said next general election shall be in favor of said annexation, that an ordinance be passed annexing said territory to the said Village of Downers Grove and that all acts necessary, prescribed by said Act, be done to complete such annexation.

RURAL CARRIER EXAMINATION

The United States Civil Service Commission has announced an examination for the County of DuPage Illinois, to be held at Elmhurst, Downers Grove, Hinsdale, Naperville and Wheaton on April 23, 1921, to fill the position of rural carrier at Hinsdale and vacancies that may later occur on rural routes from other post offices in the above-mentioned county. The salary of a rural carrier on a standard daily route of 24 miles is \$1,800 per annum, with an

additional \$30 per mile per annum for each mile or major fraction thereof in excess of 24 miles. The examination will be open only to citizens who are actually domiciled in the territory of a post office in the county who meet the other requirements set forth in Form No. 1977. Both men and women, if qualified, may enter this examination, but appointing officers have the legal right to specify the sex desired in requesting certification of eligibles. Women will not be considered for rural carrier appointment unless they are the widows of U. S. soldiers, sailors or marines, or the wives of U. S. soldiers, sailors or marines who are physically disqualified for examination by reason of injuries received in the line of military duty. Form No. 1977 and application blanks may be obtained from the offices mentioned above or from the United States Civil Service Commission at Washington, D. C. Applications should be forwarded to the Commission at Washington, D. C. at the earliest practicable date.
