The President, George Bunge, and other officers are working hard to make this a model organization.

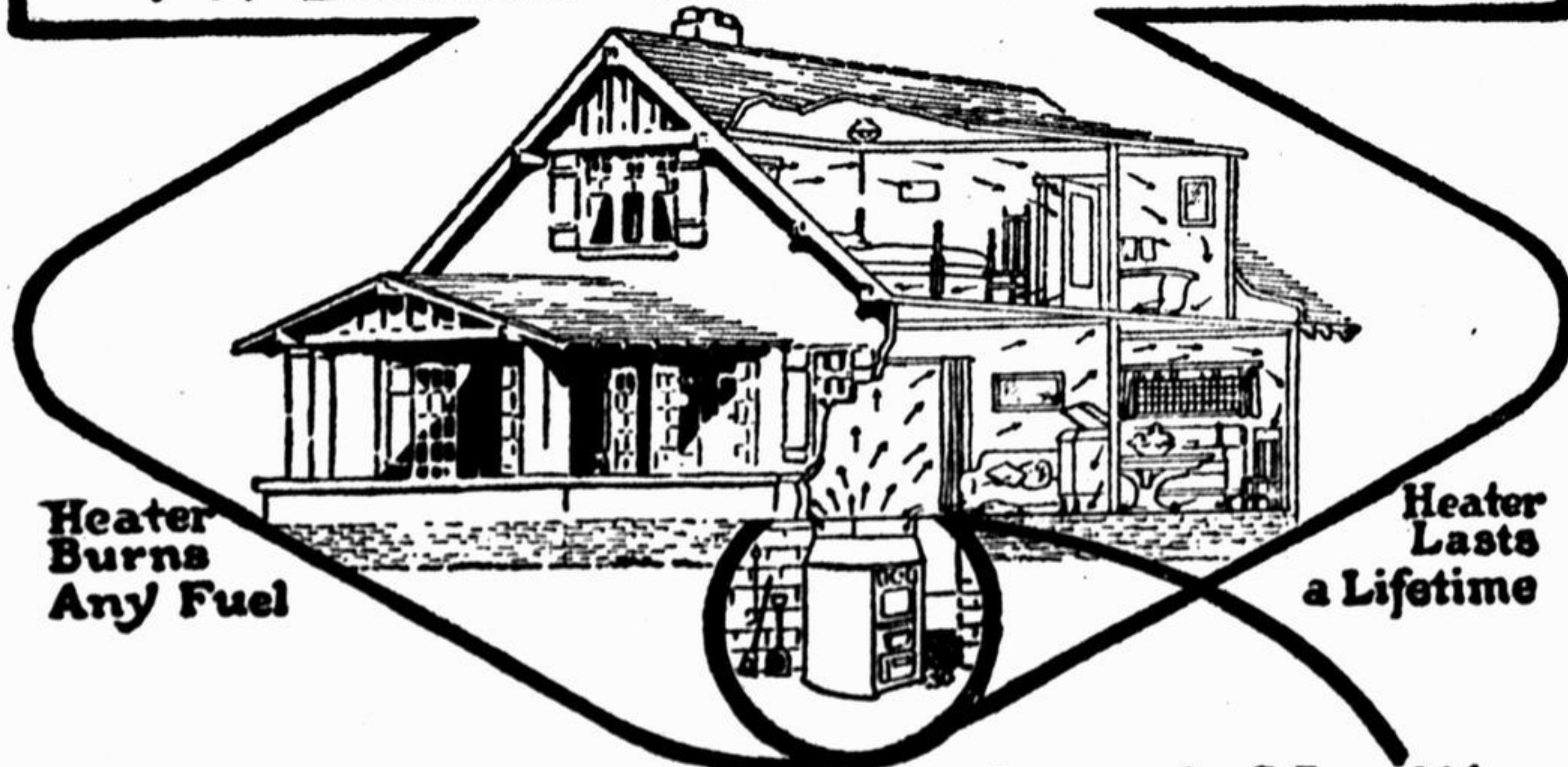
