5,667 Babies Under One Year of Age Died in Chicago Alone During 1920.

A front page headline in a Chi-THIRD NUMBER cago paper reads: "Chicago Loses 4 Million Dollars Each Year in Babies." Chicago, "The healthiest large city in the world," is seeking a remedy for this appalling loss. Prof. Irving Fischer of Yale places the potential value of every child at \$4,000.

Last year 5,667 babies under one year of age died in Chicago represnting 16.3 percent of the city's total mortality. The report of the Chicago Department of Health for the month of March of the present year is in keeping with these figures, and shows that 16.9 per cent of the total deaths were of infants under one qual statistical value.


