

AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance Submitting to the Legal Voters of Downers Grove Sanitary District, located in the County of DuPage and State of Illinois, the question whether or not bonds of said district shall be issued, amounting to \$75,000, for the purpose of defraying the cost, or as much thereof as possible, of constructing a sewage disposal plant, and outlet sewer connecting the present sewer system in the village of Downers Grove, County of DuPage and State of Illinois, with such disposal plant and acquiring the necessary land and right of way therefor, all in accordance with an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled, "An Act to Create Sanitary Districts and to Provide for Sewage Disposal" approved June 22, 1917, in force July 1, 1917, and all Acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.

Whereas it appears to the Board of Trustees of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, located in the County of DuPage and State of Illinois, that it is necessary and expedient, for the purpose of proper drainage and sewage disposal, and the preservation of the public health of the inhabitants residing within said sanitary district, that a sewage disposal plant be constructed, maintained and operated, together with an outlet sewer connecting the present system of sewers of the village of Downers Grove, located within the boundaries of said district, with such sewage disposal plant, and to acquire the necessary land and right of way for that purpose.

And Whereas, it appears to the said Board of Trustees that there are no funds, belonging to said district, available for that purpose, and that therefore it is necessary and expedient that the necessary funds for that purpose be obtained in the manner provided in and by Sections 9 and 10 of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled, "An Act to Create Sanitary Districts and to provide for sewage disposal" approved June 22, 1917, in force July 1, 1917, and all Acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; and that the sum of \$75,000 be borrowed and bonds issued therefor, all in pursuance to said Act:

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Downers Grove Sanitary District located in the County of DuPage and State of Illinois:

Purpose of Election
SECTION 1. That an election be and hereby is ordered, to be held within the boundaries of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, located in the County of DuPage and the State of Illinois, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said district, the question whether or not bonds of said district, aggregating the sum of \$75,000, be issued for the purpose of defraying the cost of constructing a sewage disposal plant, and outlet sewer connecting the present sewer system of the village of Downers Grove with said sewage disposal plant and to acquire the necessary land and right of way therefor, all of said work to be done in and for said sanitary district. Said bonds to be issued by the Board of Trustees in all respects in accordance with an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled, "An Act to Create Sanitary Districts and to provide for sewage disposal" approved June 22, 1917, in force July 1, 1917, and all Acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.

Time and Place of Holding Election
SECTION 2. That said election shall be held on Saturday, the ninth day of July, A. D. 1921, and that the Village Hall of the Village of Downers Grove, located within the boundaries of said district be and hereby is designated as the polling place for the purpose of holding said election; that the polls shall be open at seven o'clock A. M. (standard central time) and close at seven o'clock P. M. (standard central time) on that day.

Notice
SECTION 3. That notice of the time and place of holding, and of the purpose of said election shall be given by the clerk of the said Downers Grove Sanitary District by posting notices in at least five public places within the corporate limits of said district and that said notices be posted at least twenty days prior to the day on which said election is to be held; that a like notice be published in the DOWNERS GROVE REPORTER, a weekly secular newspaper printed and published in and of general circulation within the boundaries of said district, and so printed, published and circulated continuously for more than six months prior to this date; said notice shall be substantially as follows, to-wit:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in pursuance to an order, duly made and entered, by the trustees of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, located in the County of DuPage and State of Illinois, an election will be held on the ninth (9th) day of July, A. D. 1921, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters, residing within the boundaries of said Downers Grove Sanitary District, the proposition of issuing bonds to the amount of \$75,000, for the purpose of defraying the cost of constructing a sewage disposal plant and outlet sewer, connecting the present system of sewers of the village of Downers Grove with said sewage disposal plant, and to acquire the necessary land and right of way therefor, all as is provided in and by an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled, "An Act to Create Sanitary Districts and to provide for sewage disposal" approved June 22, 1917, in force July 1, 1917, and all Acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.

Said election will be held at the following polling place; the village Hall of the Village of Downers Grove, County of DuPage and State of Illinois. The polls will open at seven o'clock A. M. (standard central time) and close at seven o'clock P. M. (standard central time) on that day. Dated Downers Grove, Illinois, this 7th day of June, A. D. 1921.

AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance Submitting to the Legal Voters of Downers Grove Sanitary District, located in the County of DuPage and State of Illinois, the Question of Levying an Additional Tax of one-third of one per centum of the Value of the Taxable Property within the Corporate Limits of said District, As Assessed and Equalized for State and County Purposes; all as Provided in and by Section 12 of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled, "An Act to Create Sanitary Districts and to Provide for Sewage Disposal," approved June 22, 1917, in force July 1, 1917, and All Acts Amendatory Thereof or Supplemental Thereto.

Whereas it appears to the Board of Trustees of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, that the amount that can or will be realized from the appropriation, levy and collection of a general tax of one-third of one per centum on all the taxable property within the boundaries of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, as assessed and equalized for State and County purposes, in and for the year 1920, for general corporate purposes, will be entirely inadequate to defray the costs of organization, the cost of employing an engineer to make the necessary preliminary surveys and estimates, for the purpose of constructing an outlet sewer and sewage disposal plant, attorney fees, salaries of the Board of Trustees, salaries to other employees and divers other necessary and lawful expenses to be incurred to accomplish the purposes of the said District, all as provided in and by an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled, "An Act to Create Sanitary Districts and to provide for sewage disposal" approved June 22, 1917, in force July 1, 1917, and all Acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.

Purpose of Election

SECTION 1. That an election be and hereby is ORDERED to be held within the boundaries of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said district the question whether or not the Board of Trustees of said district shall levy a tax, of one-third of one per centum of the value of all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said district, for general corporate purposes, in and for the taxing year 1921, in addition to the tax of one-third of one per centum now authorized to be levied in and by virtue of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled, "An Act to Create Sanitary Districts and to provide for Sewage Disposal" approved June 22, 1917, in force July 1, 1917, and all Acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.

Time and Place of Holding Election

SECTION 2. That said election shall be held on Saturday, the ninth day

of July, A. D. 1921, and that the Village Hall of the Village of Downers Grove, located within the boundaries of said district, be and hereby is designated as the polling place for the purpose of holding said election; that the polls shall be open at seven o'clock A. M. (standard central time) and close at seven o'clock P. M. (standard central time) on said day.

of one per centum on all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Downers Grove Sanitary District (as assessed and equalized for State and County taxes) for general corporate purposes, in addition to the one-third of one per centum now authorized by law to be levied for the same purposes. Said election will be held at the following polling place: the Village Hall of the Village of Downers Grove, County of DuPage and State of Illinois. The polls will open at seven o'clock A. M. (standard central time) and close at seven o'clock P. M. (standard central time) on that day.

A proposition to authorize the Board of Trustees of Downers Grove Sanitary District to levy a tax of one-third of one per centum on all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said district (as assessed and equalized for State and County taxes) in addition to the one-third of one per centum now authorized by law, to be levied for general corporate purposes in and for said district, said general tax to be utilized for like purposes. Those wishing to vote in favor of the proposition will mark a cross in the square opposite the word YES, and those wishing to vote against the proposition should place a cross in the square opposite the word NO.

Return and Canvass of Ballots

SECTION 6. That the returns of said election shall be filed with the Clerk of this Board and after the ballots have been so filed they shall be canvassed and the result ascertained by this Board of Trustees, at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose, and the result of said election shall be entered upon the records of this district.

Purpose of Election

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

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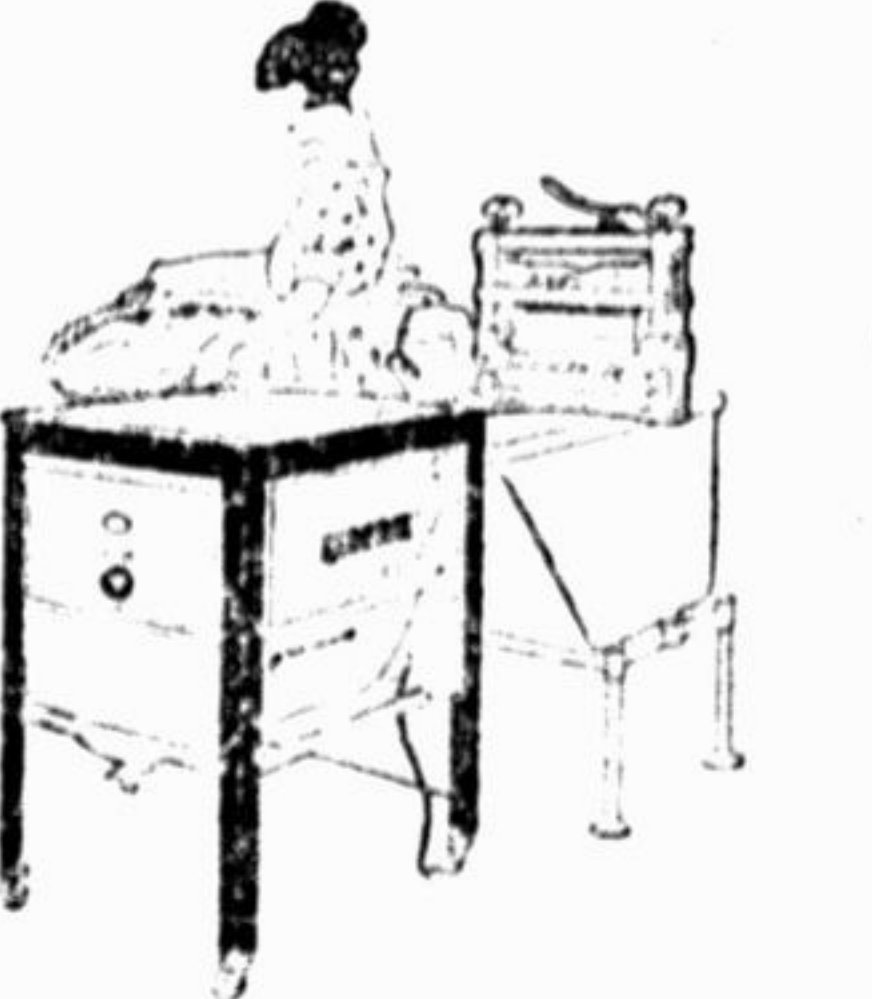


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
