



The sanitary district was organized to build an outlet sewer and disposal plant for the village of Downers Grove and to allow those living outside the corporate limits to be abl to connect up with an established sys tem, drain their lands and provide fo the sanitary disposal of all sewage.

In order to do this funds are neces sary and the trustees of the distric are asking for authority to issu bonds in the sum of \$75,000. At th same time they desire to raise th tax rate one-third of one per cent pe
