

ORDINANCE NO. 4

An ordinance providing for the issuance of bonds of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, to the amount of \$75,000.00, prescribing the form of said bonds and the interest coupons thereto attached; providing also for the levying and collection of a direct annual tax to pay the interest on and the principal of said bonds when due, and fixing other details of said issue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE DOWNERS GROVE SANITARY DISTRICT:

SECTION 1. That in pursuance to the authorization of the legal voters of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, at an election duly called and held in said district, on the ninth day of July, A. D. 1921, there be borrowed the sum of \$75,000.00, for the purpose of defraying the cost of constructing a sewage disposal plant and an outlet sewer, connecting the present sewer system of the village of Downers Grove with said disposal plant, and to acquire the necessary land and right of way therefor; that interest bearing coupon bonds be issued therefor, to the amount of \$75,000.00, by the said Downers Grove Sanitary District, seventy of said bonds to be of the denomination of \$1,000.00 each, and ten of said bonds to be of the denomination of \$500.00 each, all to bear date the fifteenth day of August, A. D. 1921, to be numbered consecutively from one to eighty, both numbers inclusive, and mature as follows:

All of said bonds to bear interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the date thereof. The first payment of interest to be made on the 15th day of February, 1922, and thereafter semi-annually on the 15th day of August in each year, and to be evidenced by interest coupons attached to each bond, to be numbered consecutively, such coupon to bear the number of the bond to which it is attached and each coupon, on each bond of the denomination of \$1,000.00, to be for the sum of \$30.00, and each coupon, on each bond of the denomination of \$500.00, to be for the sum of \$15.00, the first interest coupon, on each bond, to be payable on the 15th day of February, A. D. 1922, and each succeeding interest coupon to be payable six months after the last preceding coupon; both principal and interest to be payable at the Continental and Commercial National Bank, Chicago, Illinois, on presentation and surrender of the interest coupons as they severally become due.

Each of said bonds shall pass by delivery, unless registered, but each bond may be registered as to principal in the name of the owner on the registry books of the Treasurer of the said Downers Grove Sanitary District, such registration to be noted on the bond by the Treasurer of said Downers Grove Sanitary District, after which only such registered owner, or the legal representative of such owner, shall be entitled to receive the principal thereon, and no transfer thereof shall be valid unless made on such registry books by the registered owner in person, or by the duly authorized attorney of such owner, and similarly noted on the bond, but such bond may be discharged from registry by being transferred to bearer, after which it shall be transferable by delivery, but may be registered again as above; such registration however, shall not restrain the negotiability of the interest coupons by delivery merely.

SECTION 2. That each of said interest coupons to be thereto attached shall be in substantially the following form, respectively, to wit:

BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Downers Grove Sanitary District, located in the County of DuPage, State of Illinois, acknowledges to owe and for value received, promises to pay to bearer the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00), (or Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), as the case may be), on the 15th day of August, A. D. 1923, with interest on said sum from the date hereof, at the rate of (6) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually, on presentation and surrender of the annexed interest coupons, as they severally become due. Both principal and interest of this bond are hereby made payable at the Continental and Commercial National Bank, Chicago, Illinois; and for the prompt payment of this bond and the interest thereon, the full faith, credit and resources of the said Downers Grove Sanitary District are hereby irrevocably pledged.

This bond is one of a series of like tenor, except amount and maturity, aggregating the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00), issued for the purpose of constructing an outlet sewer and sewage disposal plant, in and for said district, including the equipment of said sewage treating plant with all necessary appliances, and the acquisition of lands and right of way therefor, under and by authority of an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled, "An Act to Create Sanitary Districts and to provide for sewage disposal" approved June 22, 1917, in force July 1, 1917, and all Acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; and as authorized by a vote of the electors of the said Downers Grove Sanitary District at an election held within said district on the ninth day of July, A. D. 1921, pursuant to said Act.

And it is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required to be done precedent

to and in the issue of this bond, have been done, happened and been performed in regular and due form, as required by law, and that the total indebtedness of said Downers Grove Sanitary District, including this bond, does not exceed the Statutory or constitutional limitations.

In testimony whereof, the trustees of the said Downers Grove Sanitary District have caused this bond to be signed by the president of said District, sealed with its corporate seal and attested by the clerk, of said District, and the annexed coupons to be executed with the facsimile signature of the said president and clerk, this fifteenth day of August, A. D. 1921.

INTEREST COUPON

D. 19... the Downers Grove Sanitary District promises to pay to bearer, at the office of its treasurer, in the Village of Downers Grove, Illinois, the sum of Thirty Dollars (\$30) (or Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00), as the case may be), for interest due that day on its Outlet Sewer and Sewage Disposal Plant Bond No. ....

Dated Downers Grove Sanitary District By Its President

That each of said bonds shall be signed on behalf of said Downers Grove Sanitary District by the President, attested by the Clerk, of said Downers Grove Sanitary District, with the seal of said District attached, and the interest coupons shall be executed by the facsimile signature of the said President and Clerk of said District; and said officials are hereby authorized and directed to so execute said bonds and coupons for and on behalf of said Downers Grove Sanitary District; that said bonds, when so executed, shall be deposited with the Treasurer of said District for safe keeping and shall be sold for such price and such rates as the trustees of said district shall from time to time determine and direct, and the proceeds derived from the sale of said bonds shall be received by the Treasurer of said District as such, and shall be used for the purposes herein set forth under the directions of the Board of Trustees of said District.

SECTION 3. That for the purpose of paying the principal and interest on said \$75,000.00, the amount of said bonds, when and as the same shall fall due, there is hereby levied and assessed for each of the years hereinafter mentioned, on all the taxable property within the Downers Grove Sanitary District, a continuing direct annual tax sufficient to produce the following sums for the following years:

SECTION 4. And the clerk of said Downers Grove Sanitary District is hereby directed in the year 1921, and in each of the years thereafter until and including the year 1931, to include the amount hereinabove levied and required to be raised by taxes in each of said years respectively, in the amount which shall be certified to the County Clerk in such year, as the amount required to be raised by taxation for said Downers Grove Sanitary District and to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of the County of DuPage and State of Illinois.

SECTION 5. Whereas, the interest falling due on said bonds on February 15, 1922, may become payable by their terms before the taxes here- in levied to pay the same shall have been wholly collected, or before said taxes shall have been paid over to the treasurer of the Downers Grove Sanitary District:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Downers Grove Sanitary District that there shall be and hereby is temporarily appropriated, out of the general fund of the Downers Grove Sanitary District, such sum or sums of money as may be necessary, properly to pay the said installment of interest last above recited. The sum so temporarily appropriated from the general fund shall be restored there- to as soon as said taxes are collected and in hand. And the President and Clerk of the Downers Grove Sanitary District are hereby directed to execute and deliver to the treasurer of said Downers Grove Sanitary District warrants for the money so used due for the payment of said one installment of interest on said bonds as the same shall fall due or so much thereof as shall have been contributed thereto out of the general fund.

SECTION 6. That the credit and resources of said Downers Grove Sanitary District be, and the same are hereby irrevocably pledged to the payments of the bonds which shall be issued in pursuance of this ordinance, and the interest thereon as it shall fall due.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.

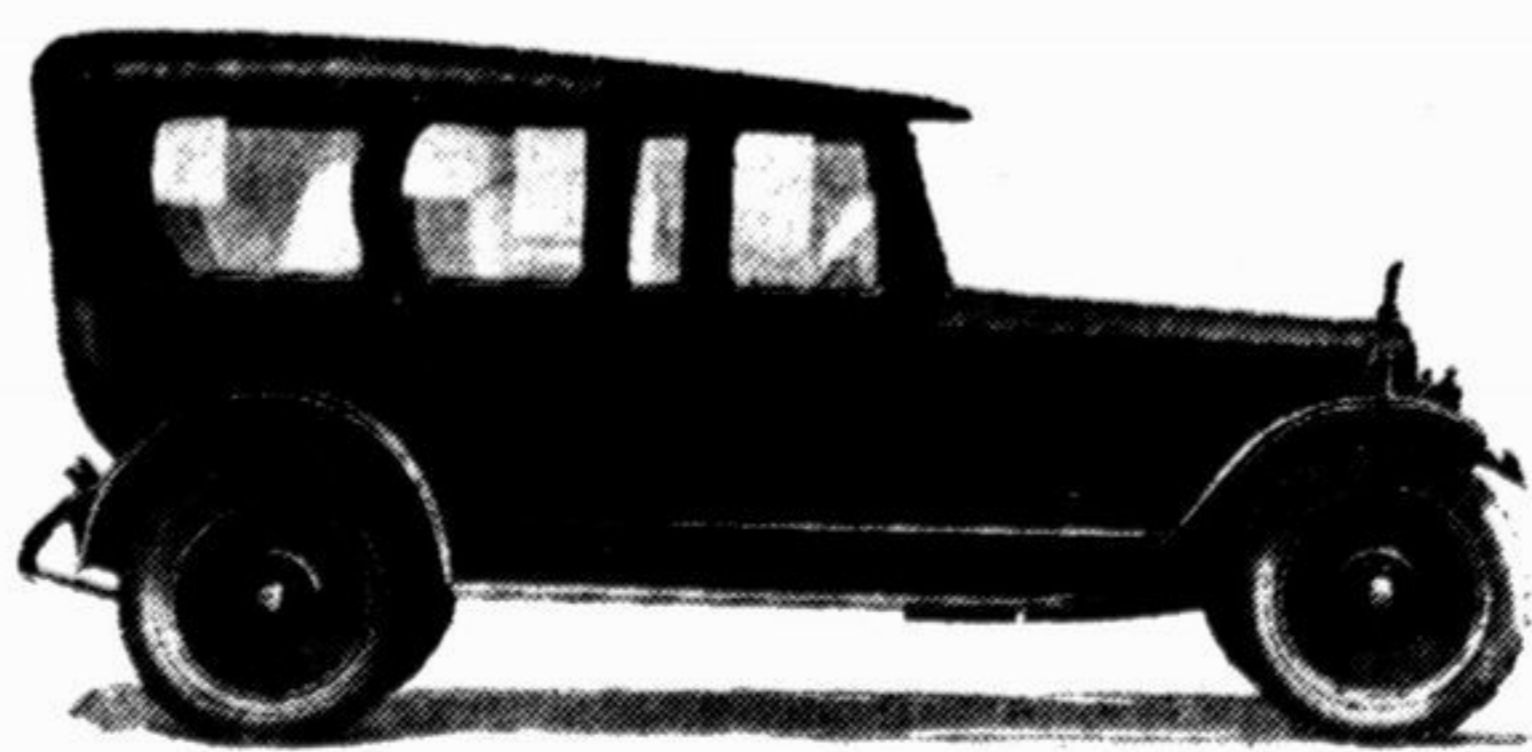
