DOWNERS **GROVE SCHOOLS**

To unify the work of the High organizations of DuPage County in the seven high schools in which such organizations have been perfected. Mr. Caster, County Y. M. C .A. workcr, accompanied by Mr. Walker, State Y. M. C. A. Secretary, visited our high school last Thursday. The plan involves the choosing of two boys from each school who will form a council whose work will be with the aid of the county secretary, to outline a program for High Y club work

This work is nation-wide in it scope. There are in the United States at present 1435 High Y clubs and 41,380 bigh school students enrolled; in Illinois last year 35 clubs were active, while this year 104 clubs with an enrollment of 2,560 indicates the growth of this movement.


