MORE HOMES FOR DU PAGE COUNTY FOUNDATION PLAN

Housing Situation Responsible for the Formation of Home Owners Foundation Here.

America needs homes. This community needs homes. DuPage County is the natural "home town" for the workers of Chicago.

To meet the situation that confronts this community, the DuPage County Home Owners Foundation has been organized. It is a mutual contractual relationship existing among a number of persons who designated in an agreement that five of their number shall act as Trustees who shall perform the terms of the contract for the mutual benefit of all persons who enter into this relationship.

The Foundation is not an investment company; it is not a corporation nor a co-partnership, nor a building and loan association, nor a cooperative society, in the ordinary sense of any of these terms.

The Trustees are bonded for the faithful performance of their duty. They are DuPage and Cook County business men who want to see DuPage County come into its own, its beautiful communities grow into larger and larger communities because of the natural places for homes, their many churches, schools, unexcelled transportation, pure air, fine water and all health-giving elements of country life with easy accessibility to their places of business.

Every precaution has been taken and every possible provision made for the safety, soundness and permanence of this plan. Annual audits by certified public accountants are provided for. Interest earnings and dividends, are paid on the basis of this audit.

Acting in conjunction with the Board of Trustees is an Advisory Board which meets frequently with the Trustees, as provided in the by-laws, and aids in carrying out the plan of operation.

The Trustees are subject to removal at any infraction or neglect of duty. They operate under the supervision of the Board composed of contract holders. The books of the Trustees are open at all times to inspection of persons interested in the success and welfare of the enterprise.

The DuPage County Home Owners Foundation is organized for the accumulation of funds to be loaned to its members (and other persons under certain conditions) for the purpose of building homes, and also to enable persons to save and accumulate funds at a good rate of interest for the same purpose.
