

FLAG ETIQUETTE

Many citizens of Downers Grove will display United States flags on Armistice Day and the "Etiquette of the Flag" should be strictly observed.

1. Do not hoist the flag before sunrise nor allow it to remain hoisted after sunset.
2. When the flag drapes a wall and is hung horizontally, the blue field should be to the left; when hung vertically the blue field should be to the right.
3. In raising or lowering flags, only the American flag should be above the others—never below.

When the flag is hung as a streamer to be viewed from both sides, as when stretched across a street, the field of blue should always be toward the east or the north.
