STARVE THE BEAST IN DU PAGE COUNTY

A beast—a monster—that feeds on boys and girls and men and women is found in every county in the State. In its constant ravages it is no respecter of person, the rich, the poor, the young and the old alike become its victims.

The people work, sleep and play year in and year out while the beast quietly, but constantly, feeds upon the inhabitants, many of them ignorant of its existence.

During the past year the Beast devoured more than 23 Du Page county people, mortally wounded or maimed for life 230 others and destroyed more than \$343,640 worth of property in DuPage county.

This beast cannot be killed by one blow. It can be starved to death. Prevention of tuberculosis through health education in the home and in the school will starve the Beast. The work of the tuberculosis association is a campaign to starve the Beast.

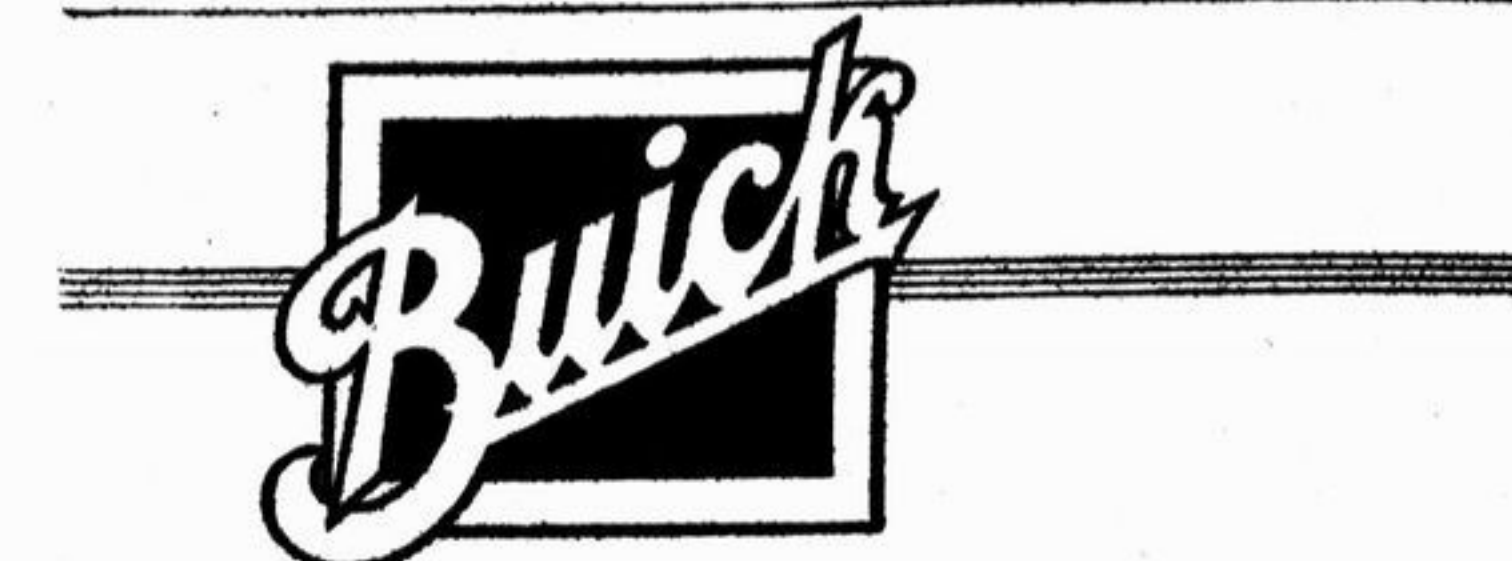
