**CALIFORNIA AHEAD ON MOTHER PENSIONS**

Judge Henry Neil of Hinsdale, Ill., the Mothers' Pension advocate has just returned from a winter campaign for Mothers' Pensions in California. He says that California is far ahead of all other States in giving pensions to mothers. For instance in Sacramento County the mothers of fatherless dependent children are paid ten dollars per month per child from State funds and an additional ten dollars per month per child from County funds so that these mothers receive twenty dollars per month per child.

In Cook County, Illinois these mothers are paid \$15 per month per child.

In DuPage County ten dollars per month per child.

In most of the other Counties of Illinois only \$3 per month per child is paid.

Judge Neil thinks that at least twenty dollars per month per child should be paid everywhere.
