Public notice is hereby given that the County Superintendent of Highways of DuPage County, Illinois, has filed in the office of the Town Clerk and Highway Commissioner of the Township of Downers Grove, DuPage County, Illinois, plans and specifications for the improvement of the following described roads in Downers Grove Township, DuPage County, Illinois:

- COUNTY LINE ROAD—**
From the northeast corner of section 36, south for 1/4 mile by hauling and spreading about 600 yards of gravel furnished by the Commissioner from Riba's pit.
- COUNTY LINE AND PRESCOTT ROAD—**
From the northeast corner of Section 36, south for one mile and from the East Quarter Corner of Section 36, west 1/4 mile by hauling and spreading about 700 yards of crushed limestone, haul not to exceed 6 miles.
- PRESCOTT ROAD—**
From the east quarter corner of Section 36, west 1/4 mile by hauling and spreading gravel from Riba's pit.
- GREGGS ROAD—**
From C. B. & Q. R. R. south, by hauling and spreading about 400 yards of screenings, haul not to exceed 10 miles.
- CLARENDON HILLS ROAD—**
From C. B. & Q. R. R. south, by hauling and spreading about 300 yards of screenings, haul not to exceed 9 miles.
- CHUSTER ROAD—**
From near the southwest corner of Section 14, westerly 60 rods, by hauling and spreading about 250 yards of 2 to 3 inch stone and about 100 yards of 1/2 to 1 1/2 inch stone, haul not to exceed 8 miles.
- MADISON STREET—**
From Plainfield Road southerly by hauling and spreading about 200 yards of 1/2 to 1 1/2 inch stone, haul not to exceed 8 miles.

The undersigned further represent, that they are desirous of having the territory herein described annexed to the said Village of Downers Grove, and become a part thereof.
Your petitioners therefore pray that the question of such annexation be submitted to the electors of said Village of Downers Grove, and that all necessary steps be taken to accomplish such annexation, all as is provided in and by an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled, "An act to provide for annexing and excluding territory to and from Cities, Towns and Villages" approved April 10, 1872, in force July 1, 1872, and all acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto. The external boundaries of said territory are as follows:
Commencing at the intersection of the center line of Orchard Street and the center line of Dunham Street, and running thence easterly along the center line of said Orchard Street, 338.5 feet, to the east line of Lot Eighty-six (86) (extended northerly in its course) of the Plat of Branigar Bros. Downers Grove Farms; thence southerly along the east line of said lot, so extended, and then continuing southerly along the east line of Lots 86, 87, 90, 91, 94, 95, 98, 99, 102 and 103, to the north line of Blanchard Street; thence westerly along the north line of Blanchard Street and the south line of said Lot 103 (as extended westerly in their courses) to the center line of said Dunham Street; thence northerly along the center line of said Dunham Street to the place of beginning, all a part of the Plat of "Branigar Bros.
