Downers Grove, Ill. June 19, 1922
Regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Downers Grove, Ill. Present at roll call Mayor W. C. Barber and Commissioners Bender, Haller, Bryce and Heartt.

Minutes of the meeting of June 12 and 14, 1922, were read and Commissioner Bryce moved to approve same. On roll call Commissioners Bryce, Bender, Haller, Heartt and Mayor Barber voted Aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

A canvas was made of the Tally Sheets and Poll Books of the Municipal Election held in Downers Grove, Illinois, on June 17, 1922, for the purpose of voting on the question "Shall certain tracts of land, known as Lot 1 of the A. C. Ducat Estate and Lots 86, 87, 90, 91, 94, 95, 98, 99, 102 and 103 of Branigan Bros. Downers Grove Farms and a strip of land lying between Maple Avenue and Dunham Street, be annexed to the Village of Downers Grove, County of DuPage, State of Illinois, which showed the following vote cast:

Commissioner Bender presented the following ordinance and moved for its passage:

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ANNEXING OF LOT ONE OF THE COUNTY CLERK'S SUBDIVISION OF PART OF THE A. C. DUCAT ESTATE.

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council of the Village of Downers Grove, County of DuPage and State of Illinois, that heretofore a petition was presented to it for the annexation of certain contiguous territory, the external boundaries of which are as follows, to-wit:

Lot 1 of the County Clerk's Subdivision of part of the A. C. Ducat Estate on the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 38 North, Range 11 east of the Third Principal Meridian in DuPage County, Illinois, Plat of which was recorded November 24, 1896, as No. 62878 in Book 5 of Plats on Page

36 in the Recorder's Office of DuPage County, Illinois.

which said territory is accurately described in the map hereto attached and made a part of this ordinance.

AND WHEREAS, it further appears that the question of said annexation was submitted to the legal voters of said Village at a special election held in and for said Village in the 17th day of June, 1922, and that a majority of all the votes cast at said election held in pursuance thereof were in all respects in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Downers Grove:

SECTION 1. That the territory herein described be and hereby is annexed to the Village of Downers Grove, in the County of DuPage and State of Illinois:

SECTION 2. That the Mayor of said Village of Downers Grove, be and he is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the said County of DuPage, as directed in and by an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled "An Act to provide for annexing and excluding territory to and from cities, towns and villages, and to unite cities, towns and villages," approved April 10, 1872, in force July 1st, 1872, and all acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, as provided by law.
