Russia, Siberia, Poland Chautauqua Lecture Subject

Lewis A. Convis at the coming Redpath Chautauqua will present a significant, informative address, "Under the Paws of the Russian Bear," telling vividly of Russia, Poland, and Siberia in relation to the problems of America.

In 1918 Mr. Convis was assigned as a civilian worker to the Polish Legion of Siberia. He remained with the Legion through varying fortunes and vicissitudes until its final destruction, when only 870 men survived out of 16,000.

Mr. Convis was peculiarly fitted to serve among Slavic peoples. For more than a decade he had been a close student of Poland and Russia and had had intimate contact with Polish and Russian peasants and upper classes both in America and Europe.

His years of study have made him thoroughly at home in the field of Russian and Polish literature, art and music; and his interpretations of the soul of the Slavic races are vital, informing and challenging.

Mr. Convis was in Warsaw during the siege of that city by the Bolsheviks and witnessed the magnificent defense

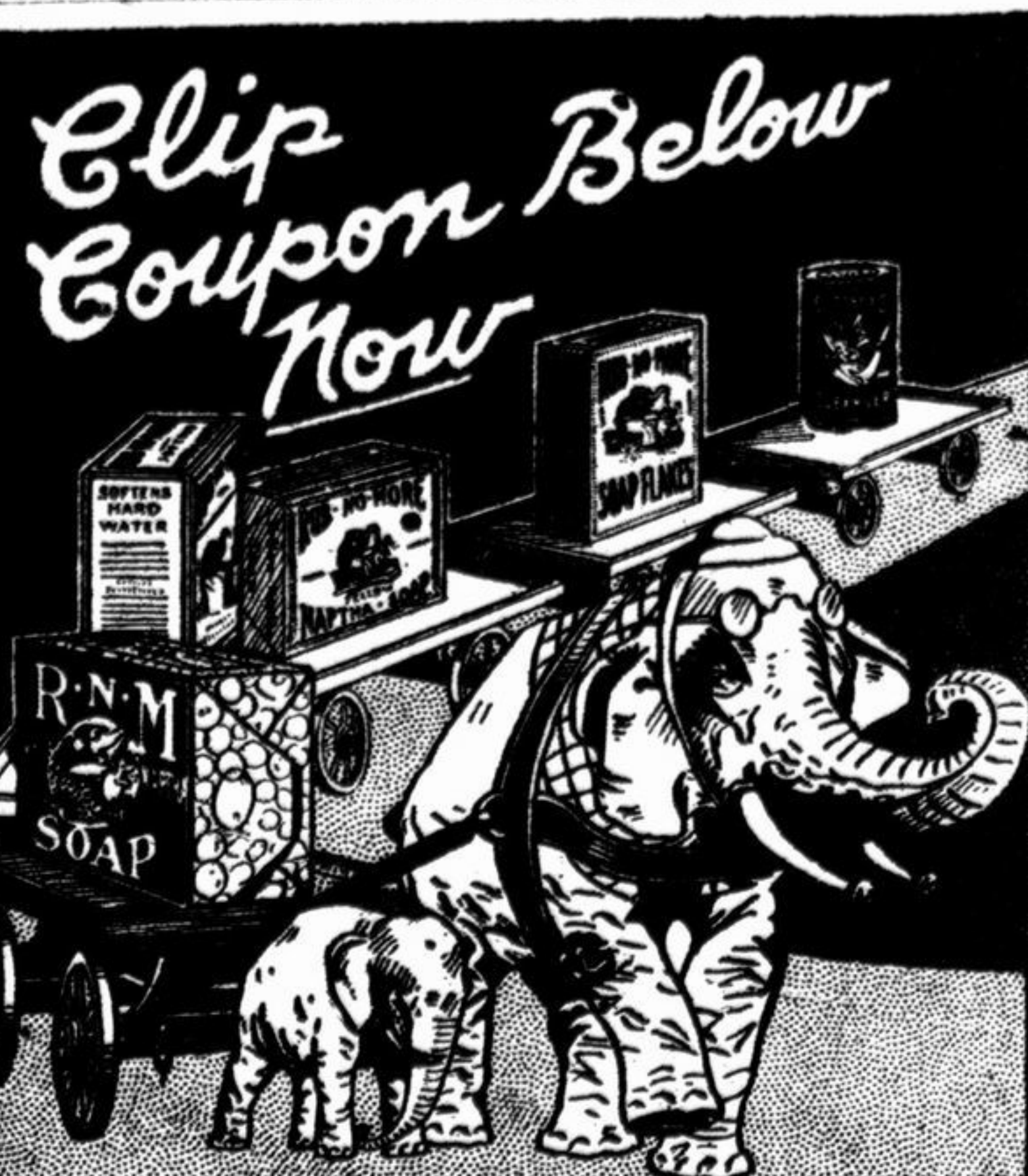
