Even while President Lewis of the United Mine Workers was in Washington, conferring with Secretary of Labor, Davis—(below), and later with President Harding, riot was ruling at Herrin, Ill., where forty were killed and many wounded before order was restored. Above is shown all that was left of the power house at a strip mine in Herrin, Ill., after dynamite and the torch had been applied. President Lewis refused to agree to plans proposed by President Harding and Secretary Davis to end the strike.
