The attitude at each of the meetings was described as strongly favorable.

"We are out for more money for our milk," said J. T. Williams, president of the marketing company, "but we are opposed to increasing the price to the consumer. We have no griev ance against anybody but ourselves. Now we believe we have found the remedy.

The outstanding idea on which we are organizing, is that the producer is entitled to one-half of the consumer's dollar, and that an increase in retail price is unnecessary in order to pay us this one-half. The dairyman receives less money for owning his cows, caring for them and milking them than the milk driver receives in Chicago for doing nothing more than carrying bottles from his wagon to the back doors."
