# OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL

Downers Grove, Ill., July 31, 1922.

Regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Downers Grove, Ill. Present at roll call Mayor W. C. Barber and Commissioners Bender, Haller, Bryce and Heardt.

Minutes of the meeting of July 24, 1922, were read and Commissioner Heardt moved to approve same. On roll call Commissioners Heardt, Haller, Bryce and Mayor Barber voted Aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

Bids for Air Lift Equipment for the Water Plant, as re-advertised, were received, opened and read to the Village Council and the bidders—the following firms bidding: Harris Air Pump Co., Sullivan Machinery Co., Worthington Pump & Machinery Corporation, Indiana Air Pump Co., Chicago Pneumatic Tool Co., and Ingersoll-Rand Co., of Illinois. The bids were ordered placed on file for public inspection.

Commissioner Bender moved to adjourn to a special meeting to be held August 2, 1922 at 7:30 o'clock p. m. On roll call Commissioners Bender, Bryce, Haller, Heardt and Mayor Barber voted Aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

Downers Grove, Ill., Aug. 2, 1922. Special meeting of the Council of the Village of Downers Grove, Ill. Present at roll call Mayor W. C. Barber and Commissioners Bender, Haller, Bryce and Heardt.

Reading of the minutes of July 31, 1922 was dispensed with on motion of Commissioner Heardt. On roll call Commissioners Heardt, Haller, Bryce and Mayor Barber voted Aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

Commissioner Bender submitted recommendation of the Council acting as a Board of Local Improvements, together with an ordinance, providing for the local improvement of grading the roadways and parkways, constructing storm water inlets, constructing a concrete culvert, constructing curb and gutter, placing to line and grade existing storm water inlets and placing to grade existing manhole covers, and paving the roadways of North Washington Street, from the north line of Warren Avenue to the South line of Chicago avenue; Rogers street from the east line of Highland avenue to the west line of Elm street; East Franklin Street from the east line of Highland Avenue to the west line of North Washington Street; East Prairie Avenue from the east line of Highland Avenue to the west line of North Washington Street, all in the Village of Downers Grove, DuPage County, Illinois, and recommending that a petition be filed in the County Court said improvement to be known as Special Assessment No. 62, and moved that the ordinance be passed. On roll call Commissioners Bender, Haller, Bryce, Heardt and Mayor Barber voted Aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

Commissioner Bryce presented the following resolution and moved that same be passed:


