Downers Grove 37 Years Ago

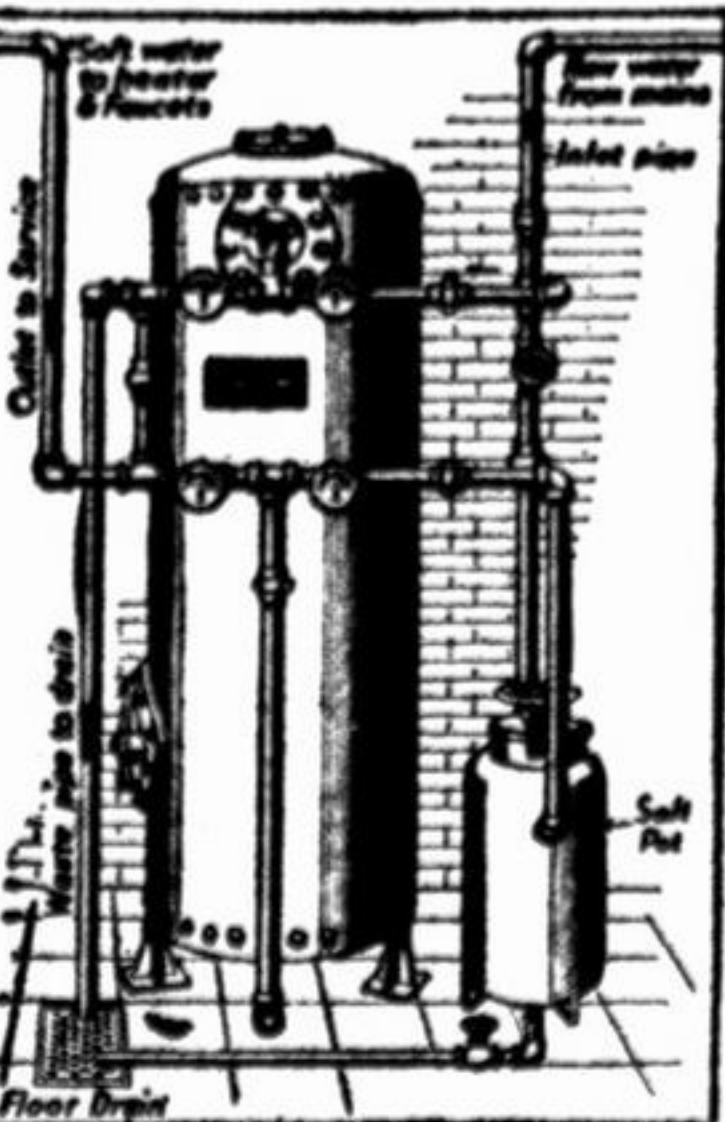
