Downers Grove, Ill., October 16, 1922. Regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Downers Grove, Illinois. Present at roll call Mayor W. C. Barber and Commissioners Bender, Haller, Bryce. Minutes of the meeting of October 9, 1922 were read and Commissioner Bryce moved to approve same. On roll call Commissioners Bryce, Bender, Haller and Mayor Barber voted Aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

On roll call Commissioners Bryce, Bender, Haller and Mayor Barber voted Aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

Commissioner Haller presented an ordinance entitled "An ordinance changing the present method of handling fire calls in the Village of Downers Grove, Illinois and moved for its passage. On roll call Commissioners Haller, Bender, Bryce and Mayor Barber voted Aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

**RESOLUTION**

**RESOLVED**, That whereas it is proposed by the County Commissioners of DuPage County to submit to the voters of said County a bond issue for the purpose of improving certain roads in the county with concrete, tarvia or other approved systems of hard road construction, and

**WHEREAS**, Highland Avenue in the Village of Downers Grove is included within the proposed improvements, if said bond issue successfully carries, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, That the Council of said Village respectfully request said County Commissioners to include for said Highland Avenue, between the Plank Road, otherwise known as Ogden Avenue, and Chicago Avenue in said Village, concrete construction for a width of 18 feet, and the Village Council of Downers Grove, pledges itself to take the necessary steps to make said street solid concrete for a width of 27 feet within said village so that it will be of same width as Highland Avenue present pavement extended.
