Top left: Recipes for food bulletins and for use in courses and lectures are tested in our staff kitchen. A great deal of experimental work is carried on here in cooking, food preservation and the testing of products.

Upper right: The office staff have a busy life answering correspondence, typing material to be mimeographed, sending out forms, checking reports, and in general maintaining a connection by mail with the farthest Institute.
