Tansley — For an International Day program, each member was given the name of a member society in the Associated Country Women of the World. For roll call the member told some interesting fact about her assigned country. For lunch, foods from countries other than Canada were served.

Nestleton — New Canadian members told of their experiences when becoming Canadian citizens. One woman spoke to the group, using the subject "What the Women's Institute Means to Me."

Marburg — Roll Call — "What would I say to an A.C.W.W. member other than a member of the Ontario Women's Institute, about F.W.I.O.?"

Fergus — Linens, jewellery, pottery, glass, a rug and a parasol were a few of the articles shown when members answered a Roll Call which asked them to bring an article from a member country of A.C.W.W. A speaker described a trip to an International Boy Scout Camp in Sweden.

Cornwall Centre — A local Immigration Officer explained the difference between immigration and customs. He listed the qualifications needed before applying to immigrate and mentioned that over fifty per cent of emigrants become Canadian citizens.
