REPORT — ERLAND LEE HOMESTEAD COMMITTEE

The Erland Lee Homestead is situated on the Ridge Road, Stoney Creek, Lot 17, Concession 4, Saltfleet Township, County of Wentworth. On the brow of the escarpment the Homestead overlooks Stoney Creek and Lake Ontaio. Ridge Road forms part of the County Scenic Drive and is a portion of the Bruce Trail.

The Homestead is located in an historic part of Ontario and there are many places of historic interest and beauty worthy of a visit in the area. An historic plaque has already been placed on the lawn by the Ontario Archeological and Historic Sites Board.

The property consists of 2.9 acres, 270 feet

by 360 feet. As well as the Homestead located near the front of the property there is a small house, now rented, located at the back and a small red barn. Improvements made to the Home since its purchase on June 15, 1972 are as follows:

The basement floor, which is under the whole house, has been cemented — a great improvement.

A new oil tank was installed to replace the rusted one.

A rug and three chairs have been purchased from the Lee Estate.

The front hedge which was unwieldly, has been removed.

Some trees have been trimmed, the grass and flower beds maintained.
