


This summer, the Ontario Science Centre in Toronto will host the "First World Crafts Exhibition", an exhibition of over 100 craft items from fifty-two countries.

One of these activities is the making of a massive patchwork quilt which will be hung and displayed as it is being patched. You are invited to make a patch of your own design which will be applied to the backing during the 3-month marathon "quilting bee."

REQUIREMENTS:

The ground fabric should be cotton broadcloth to overcome hanging problems.

The patch should be approximately 12" x 12". This will be hemmed at 10" x 10" before being applied.

We would appreciate having your name applied on the patch. The exhibition will be much more than simply a display of crafts. Ethnic performances will complement international crafts. Craft-making and craft activities invite visitor participation.



It is hoped that, if you create a patch, you will be able to bring it to the exhibition and join in the quilting bee when the patch is being applied.

The design of the patch can be as simple or as complex as you wish to make it.
