Make one quilt block-sewn by hand, preferably.

Attach block to sheet of paper. Include the name of the quilt pattern. But, do not write on the quilt block!

On a separate sheet of paper, to be placed at back of block, draw templates the exact size of your quilt pattern, including a 1/4" seam allowance.

Also state: size + number of blocks required; size of the finished quilt; the yardage required; detailed instructions or a graph showing how to assemble the quilt, and details regarding border.

Package front-quilt block, back-templates and the directions.

Attach front and back to heavy cardboard. Cover with clear plastic.
