SCHOOL BELL

"If the bell could speak its memory, it would tell of calling many children to their classes and farmers to their meals."

The bell, a former land mark at the Winchelsea school SS No. 6 Osborne Township, was first in the white brick school built in 1868, then placed in the new school built in 1920 and closed in 1964. In excellent condition for its years, the bell, well over a century old weighed around 400 pounds.

This project by Hurondale Elimville and Kirkton Branches was undertaken in order to preserve the beautiful old bell, place it on a cairn and mark it with a historic plaque.
