Continue your metric programs. Include relevant details not just bare bones in report to next level.

## AGRICULTURE AND CANADIAN INDUSTRIES

Make use of the topics in handbook and use the Loan Library. Send your Branch report on immediately after annual meeting is a good rule to follow.

District Consumers should include number of branches serving 100% is no help.

Area Consumers—don't be the one to hold up the Provincial Consumer.

## CITIZENSHIP AND WORLD AFFAIRS

It cannot be emphasized too strongly that in the District and Area report the correct number of branches for each District and correct number of Districts should be included in the report.

Do not try to cover both Citizenship and World Affairs at one meeting.

## EDUCATION AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Suggested topics in handbook as well as current concerns and local issues provide ideas for interesting meetings.

District Consumers should assume more responsibility. If you have a delinquent branch get in touch with that Consumer. Tardiness on your part means delay for the Area Consumer.

Area Consumers—do not be the Consumer to hold up the report at Provincial level—October 1 is your deadline.

## RESOLUTIONS

Before formulating a resolution—investigate. Write to appropriate authorities, someone who might throw light on your problem. You may find the solution without making a resolution.

Complete research material must accompany resolution or it will not be accepted. Refer to handbook on methods for handling local or provincial resolutions—there is a difference.
