Retiring President by virtue of her office is the Immediate Past President.

All Executive Officers may vote at Executive Meetings.

Each Area may have their own by-laws, which shall not contravene the Handbook.

Official Voting Delegates to Area Convention:

Each Branch shall elect one delegate.

Each District shall elect the District President and Federation Representatives as their delegates.

(Alternates elected for all delegates).

Quorum: $\frac{1}{2}$ of Area Board of Directors entitled to vote, must be present at Board Directors Meetings.

$\frac{1}{3}$ of Branch and District delegates, entitled to vote, must be present at Area Convention.

All Branch Members are eligible to attend the Convention. When it is your District's turn for a Provincial Board Director, the District Secretary will receive a list from the Provincial Secretary of all Federation Representatives and alternates who have served since the District was last represented on the Provincial Board.

It is the duty of the District Secretary to mail the lists of all these names to the other District Secretaries in the Subdivision before District Annual.

Each District Secretary shall mail a copy to all Branch Secretaries in the Subdivision, by September 1 so the voting delegate will be familiar with the eligible names.

Provincial Board Director:

Is the official voice for the Subdivision, and

Is elected at Convention by voting delegates from her Subdivision.
