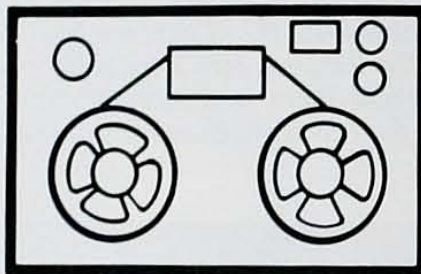
Ontario's new twin
