Anne explains how her fundraising efforts help women and girls in Afghanistan by paying a teacher's salary. Anne charges \$25 to come to a meeting, a bridal shower or a gathering of friends and there is also the opportunity to donate extra funds into a basket. When she has reached the sum of \$750, she forwards it on to the head of the organization in Calgary. This is Anne's own unique way of raising funds for the organization.
