

What international opportunities are there for FWIO Members?


The following have been described in previous *Home & Country ROSE Garden* issues.

- FWIO is supporting Grandmothers in Rwanda (March 1, 2007-March 1, 2008) through the Stephen Lewis Foundation's "Grandmothers to Grandmothers" campaign.
- The FWIO-Caribbean, Central and South America Area small crafts project will continue, as long as there is need and interest. FWIO Board Directors have the details. They have also been published in "The Connecting Link".
