Thimble Relay

Split the group into teams of 3 or 4 Members each. The objective is to have each Member of the team walk a distance without dropping the thimble from their spoon.

Ugly Fabric Dare

Everyone contributes one yard of fabric. The fabric is passed around as music is played. When the music stops, everyone must rip their fabric in half and pass the other half around when the music starts again. The game continues until the last piece is 4 x 4. By this time, everyone has a lot of different fabrics in a lot of different sizes. The dare is to make something of it!

Strip Poker

Played with cards, but the betting money is strips of fabric (what did you think we meant?). It doesn't have to be poker or even a full card game. Try a high card draw or slap jack with the winner getting all the strips on the table!
