✓ DO send

- Profiles of Women's Institute members

✓ DO keep your article to 250 words or less. All submissions will be reviewed and edited at the discretion of the Home & Country ROSE Garden Editor.

✓ DO take interesting pictures

- An action shot is more compelling than a posed or static image. (i.e. members participating in your ROSE event, quilting, cooking, dancing etc.)
- Remember to have an extra copy of your photo. Due to the quantity of photos received, photos will not be returned after submission.

✗ DON'T send

- District Annual and Area Convention reports and photographs
- Anniversary celebration reports and photographs, including 100th anniversaries (these can be sent to the provincial office labelled "web site").
- Tributes to deceased members (with the exception of Provincial Presidents)
- Minutes or newspaper clippings of Branch meetings

✗ Don't get discouraged if your article doesn't appear right away. We keep all submissions on file and do our best to include all stories that meet the criteria listed above.
