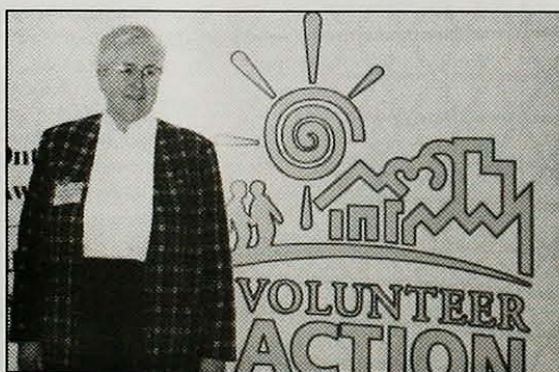
## Willa McCann Commended by Codrington WI
