A Fun 31-Day Fundraising Idea


ere is an easy and fun fundraising idea you can do with Branch members.

All you need is some spare change – lots of pennies – and a bag.

Day

- 1 Put 1 cent in the bag for each year of your age.
- 2 If it's sunny, put in 10 cents; if it's raining, put in 5 cents.
- 3 Put in 5 cents for each meal you eat today; 10 cents for each meal you eat outside the home.
- 4 Put in 2 cents for each number in your shoe size.
- 5 Put in 1 cent for each inch of your waist measurement.
- 6 Put in 1 cent for each letter in your full name.
- 7 If your hair is blonde, put in 21 cents; if black, 16 cents; if red, 10 cents; if brown, 9 cents; all other colours, 6 cents. If your hair is dyed, add 10 cents.
- 8 If you play a musical instrument (even a comb and tissue paper) put in 10 cents.
- 9 Put in 5 cents for each cup of tea or coffee you drink today.
- 10 Put in 5 cents for each time you used your car today. If a friend drove you, put in 10 cents. If you didn't go out, put in 5 cents.
- 11 Put in 2 cents for each living plant in your home.
- 12 Put in 5 cents for each brother and sister you have.
- 13 If your eyes are brown, put in 15 cents; if blue, 10 cents; all other colours, 8 cents.
- 14 Put in 10 cents for each TV in your home and 5 cents for each radio.
- 15 Put in 5 cents for each bed in your home.
- 16 Put in 10 cents for each telephone in your home.
- 17 Put in 10 cents for each piece of small mail you received today.
- 18 Put in 10 cents for each bathroom in your home.
- 19 Write down the last two digits of your phone number and put that amount in the bag.
- 20 Put in 3 cents for each clock in your home.
- 21 Put in 5 cents for each of your children and 2 cents for each grandchild.
- 22 If you own a dog, put in 10 cents; a cat, 9 cents; a bird, 5 cents; a fish, 3 cents. If you ever owned an animal you loved, put in 15 cents.
- 23 Put in 5 cents for each bone you've broken; 25 cents if you've never broken a bone.
- 24 Put in 5 cents for each ring you wear regularly.
- 25 Put in 2 cents for each electrical appliance in your kitchen.
- 26 Put in 2 cents for each lightbulb in the room you're in right now.
- 27 Put in 5 cents for each phone call you received today.
- 28 Put in 2 cents for each button you're wearing right now.
- 29 Put in 5 cents for each dessert you eat today.
- 30 If your first name starts A to L, put in 5 cents; if M to Z, put in 8 cents. If you go by a nickname, add 5 cents.

The Erland Lee (Museum) Home recently got new road signs on the QEW and on several local roads.
