FWIO International Exchange - 1999

- with Michigan Association for Family & Community Education

Applicant:

- a Federated Women's Institute of Ontario (FWIO) member will be selected by the FWIO as part of the International Exchange and Study Program

Purpose:

- to increase the understanding of others and to help FWIO members gain a deeper insight into the people of other countries

Requirements:

The FWIO member selected :

- will have qualities and attitudes of acceptable standards of others, yet support FWIO as a typical member
- will not be a member of the Provincial Board of Directors
- will be knowledgeable of FWIO programs and aims
- will be available for five to seven days some time between April and October, at a mutually agreeable time and place with hostess
- will be independent, possess initiative and manage her own travel arrangements
- will understand this is a study program
- will show warmth and friendliness and be sensitive to the views of others
- will show willingness to accept speaking opportunities while visiting
- will tell membership of her experiences and provide a written report to Board

Expenses:

- It is understood that expenses will be incurred by the applicant depending on her requirements and personal taste. Costs will include travel, slides or pictures of the exchange and hostess gifts as appropriate (etc.). FWIO will pay up to \$500 toward the applicant's International Exchange and Study Program.

Time Required:

- five to seven days between April and October at a time agreeable to hostess and applicant; to be mutually arranged
