

By January of 1965 the Arran and Tara Boards were amalgamated with three trustees elected from Arran Township and two from Tara. Members of the Board at the time of writing (1965) included Ken Wagner, John Fenton, Walter Hogg, Don Thompson, and Glen Graham. Eldon Nicholson was named Secretary-Treasurer of this new board.

A few improvements have been made to the school, chief of which include the installation of hydro in the mid 1940's, an inside stairway about 1950; the ceiling was lowered and tiled about 1962 and in the summer of 1964 an oil furnace was installed and a furnace room built.
