

After the death of Mrs. Chas. Baker (Mamie Underwood) at Arkwright, relatives cleaning out the house came across some old letters that had been sent to the family from either relatives or old friends in Ireland, in the late 1800's. These letters have been preserved by Jack Underwood of Exeter. I note all the Underwoods was born in the Town Land of Shamer County Donegal, Ireland. It also says Lady Crafer was born in Old Shamer beside the Underwoods. Others mentioned in the letters were James and Thomas Graham (spelled Gramer) and old Aty Gramer in Ireland, Moses Crafer, Mary Esabela and Bess Harn (Harron) Billy Jackson, father of young William, old Andersons Ann. Freeborn, Aunt Jane McClay and others. The letters were mostly to Ann. and Andy Underwood and to Robert White, from a bro. of James and Thomas Graham who must also have lived in Clarke
