veil was held in place by an embroidered tiara. She carried red roses.

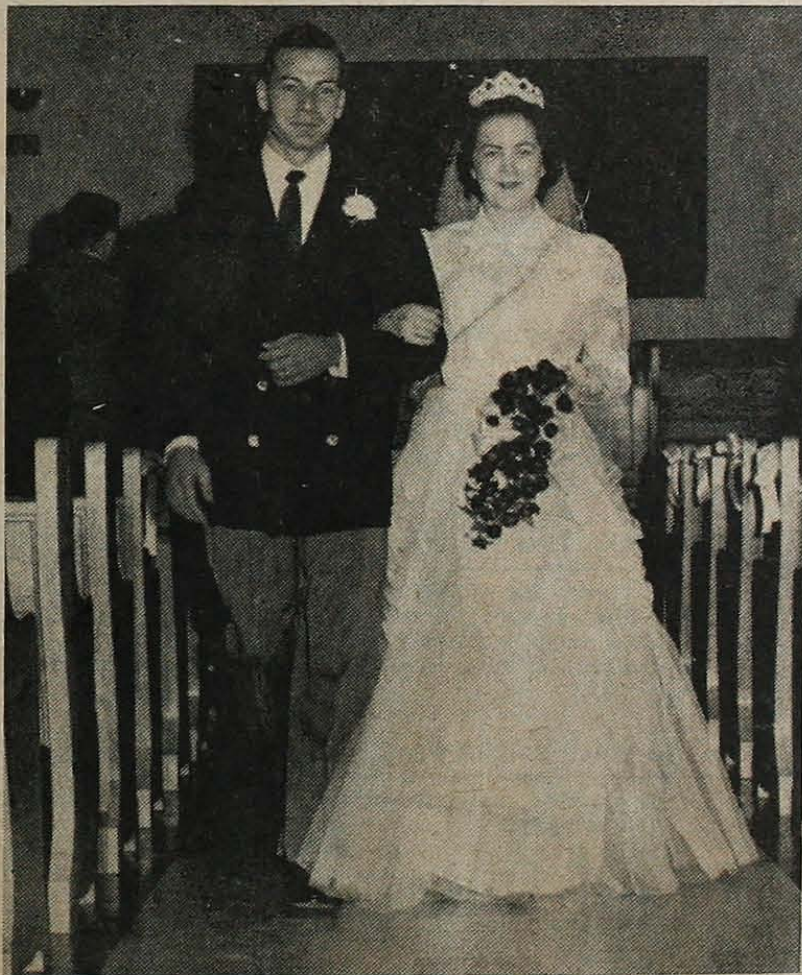
The bridesmaid wore a floor length gown of lace and net over peacock blue taffeta, with a lace bolero and a lace bandeau with pearls.
