## Belmont-Methuen Township Municipal Building

In the year 1855 the Townships of Belmont and Methuen separated from the Township of Asphodel and became the United Townships of Belmont-Methuen until the years 1855-1864 when the Municipality became known as the United Townships of Belmont, Methuen, Chandos, Cardiff, Harcourt and Bryunton. This continued until 1865 when the municipality once again became the Townships of Belmont and Methuen and has continued as such to the present day.

In March 1833 the council of that year Reeve Brown and Councillors Wilde,
Bonar, Anderson and Boyd - prepared
plans to build a township hall. They made a
contract with Napoleon Preneveau to
purchase the land of the present hall site
and let the contract for building to Mr.
Preneveau was paid \$400 in September
1883 and another \$400 in September
1883 and another \$400 in December 1883,
In December 1883 the council contracted
with Mr. Preneveau to lath, plaster and
supply desk, table and chairs for the hall
for the amount of \$150. and that amount

was to be paid from taxes levied in 18 This was paid in December 1884. At I meeting it is noted that a resolution y passed authorizing the payment of \$1 for a cord of wood for use at the town hall. The wood was to be supplied by Anderson, and an order was issued Mark Scott for the sum of \$2.00 for dief the hall.
