The By Laws of the Belmore Chamber of Commerce

as written and adopted in 1974

- No. 1 That this Chamber of Commerce have a minimum of 12 regular meetings per year.
- No. 2 That the membership fee be set at \$5.00 per members.
- No. 3 That all moneys (except that portion of money used to raise money) be used for the support of the Belmore Community Centre and the support of benevolent causes within the community.
- No. 4 That this chamber of commerce pay dues to belong to the Ontario Chamber of Commerce.
- No. 5 That 3 new directors be appointed each year with 3 dropping off.

A motion was made at the annual meeting in 1979 to add By Law No. 6.

No. 6 That in any year, only those people who are members of the Chamber of Commerce are eligible for nomination as directors for the coming year.

A motion was made at the annual meeting in 1996 to Delete By-Law No. 4 which requires membership in the Ontario Chamber of Commerce.
