Clavering - "A post village in Grey County, Ont.
18 miles from Owen Sound
population 100."

1895 on Mill Creek and a station on the
G.T.R. It contains one Union Church,
one store, two saw mills and two
shingle mills population 150.

1895

Warton, an incorporated village in Bruce County,
Ont; at the head of Colpoys Bay, on the G.T.R.,
20 miles from Owen Sound. The Harbour is
one of the best on Georgian Bay. It contains six
churches, one mechanics' Institute, one branch bank,

two printing offices issuing weekly newspapers, saw,
grist and planing mills and several hotels and stores
population 1,984.

1881

Warton - a post village in Bruce County Ont., at
the head of Colpoys Bay, 20 miles from Owen
Sound. The harbour is one of the best on Georgian Bay.
The Stratford and Lake Huron Rwy will have
its northern terminus here. Population 900
